| <i>Question</i> | When is HP discontinuing AIO Ready Subset 5.1x? |
| <i>Answer</i> | Effective January 1, 2014, HP is announcing the discontinuance of AIO Ready Subset 5.1x . Current customers may continue to purchase additional licenses of AIO Ready Subset 5.1x until March 1, 2014. As of this date, the product will be removed from HP's Corporate Price List and will no longer be orderable. |
| <i>Question</i> | What product numbers are affected by this obsolescence? |
| <i>Answer</i> | Please refer to Appendix B in the customer letter for the list of affected product numbers. |
| <i>Question</i> | When is the last date I can order AIO Ready Subset 5.1x? |
| <i>Answer</i> | AIO Ready Subset 5.1x will continue to be available for purchase to current support customers through March 1, 2014. As of that date, you will no longer be able to purchase additional licenses of the product. |
| <i>Question</i> | Can I still purchase additional licenses for AIO Ready Subset 5.1x? If yes, how? |
| <i>Answer</i> | Additional licenses may not be purchased for versions that are discontinued and past their end of sale date. |
| <i>Question</i> | Who can I contact if I have more questions with regards to this product discontinuance? |

Answer The End of Support date for AIO Ready Subset 5.1x is December 31, 2016. As of this date all customer support activities for this version will cease, this includes:

- Product upgrades

Question Are there any other key dates I need to be aware of?

Question What are my discontinuance options?

Answer Customers have the option to continue using AIO Ready Subset 5.1x. HP will stop providing support for AIO Ready Subset 5.1x on December 31, 2016. Customers are encouraged to begin reviewing their business requirements for AIO Ready Subset 5.1x. Customers are also encouraged to contact their local HP Sales Representative or HP Software Business Partner for help in determining migration options that meet your business needs.

Question Can I get a support contract for technical support only, without having to pay for upgrades?

Answer No, support contracts include both technical support and software updates.

Question Should there be a defect with a version of AIO Ready Subset 5.1x for which no defect fixing is done anymore, can I pay for a fix to be implemented on my request?

Answer HP may choose to offer defect fixes at a premium price, depending on available resources.

Question Can I continue my existing support contracts until they expire?

Answer Yes, you can continue using your existing support contracts until they expire.
