Compatibility matrix

Features

The following sections describe the new features of the Get-Resources Tailoring Kit.

Custom portal components

You can create and add your own custom portal components with the Get-Resources Tailoring Kit.

Data validation

The Get-Resources Tailoring Kit now includes information on how to add custom data validation to your forms and scripts. See the *Get-Resources Tailoring Kit Guide* for details.

Default values

The Get-Resources Tailoring Kit now includes information on how to add custom default values to your forms components. See the *Get-Resources Tailoring Kit Guide* for details.

DocExplorer References

You can now add DocExplorer functionality to custom forms using a DocExplorer Reference. A DocExplorer Reference is a special template that redirects users to a full DocExplorer activity along with two parameters: the schema and adapter to be used. You can use a DocExplorer Reference to quickly add and configure DocExplorer functionality to new forms.

Integration with Rhino JavaScript Debugger

You can now configure the Get-Resources Tailoring Kit to integrate with the Rhino JavaScript debugger provided by Mozilla. The Rhino JavaScript Debugger provides a graphical user interface for debugging interpreted JavaScript and ECMAScript. When you enable the Rhino JavaScript Debugger, you can log on to the Get-Resources server and see debugging information about your installation as you browse through the Get-Resources interface.

Schema extensions

You can make additions or changes to existing schemas using schema extensions. Schema extensions allow you to save customized logical and physical mappings in separate files that preserve the original schema files shipped by Peregrine Systems. This separate file organization ensures that any upgrades will not overwrite your tailoring changes.

Get-Resources Tailoring Kit

The following table lists the known issues and temporary solutions for the Get-Resources Tailoring Kit.

<p>Uninstalling the Get-Resources Tailoring Kit requires removing any instance of Get-Resources that is also on the system.</p> <p>In addition, the uninstallation process removes any installed services for the Apache web server and the Tomcat application server on the system.</p> <p>[ST28309]</p>	<p>To uninstall the Get-Resources Tailoring Kit and preserve your development environment settings:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Save a copy of the following application data to recreate your development environment: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ WEB-INF\local.xml ■ all files under WEB-INF\etc\grtrees\user\ 2 Uninstall the Get-Resources Tailoring Kit. 3 Uninstall the Peregrine Portal. 4 Re-install the Java 2 SDK 5 Re-install Get-Resources and any other Get-It applications you had installed. 6 Re-install the Get-Resources Tailoring Kit. 7 Restore your Get-Resources Tailoring Kit data. <p>To fully uninstall the Get-Resources Tailoring Kit:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Uninstall the Get-Resources Tailoring Kit. 2 Uninstall the Peregrine Portal.

Peregrine Studio

The following table lists the known issues and temporary solutions for Peregrine Studio.

Issue	Temporary Solution
On the Tools menu, select Options > Advanced. In the Advanced dialog box, all options can be selected.	<p>Do not activate any Advanced options except “Use HTTP listener.” You can select the HTTP Listener option if you have set “Display Form Information” to <i>true</i> to access Peregrine Studio forms directly from Web interface.</p> <p>If you use the other advanced options to edit source packages or the tools library, you may not be able to install future versions of Get-Resources. Any modifications made using Advanced Options will invalidate your Support agreement with Peregrine.</p>
When adding a template to a form, the template is not added properly if you use a drag-and-drop method or copy and paste the template.	To add a template to a form, right-click on the form. Select New, and then the template you want from the menu.
When trying to edit a label for a fieldtableheading or fieldtablerow component, there is no label field displayed in the tab view.	Select the fieldtable component in the Project Explorer. This will display the fieldtable on the right side of the Studio window. Select the Columns tab. The label can be edited in the label area.
When you first open your project in Peregrine Studio, a conflict icon (red exclamation point) is displayed next to the Project node.	No conflict resolution is required. You can ignore this conflict warning.

Issue	Temporary Solution
Your first attempt to build your project produces compile errors.	<p>Before attempting to build the Web application project in Peregrine Studio for the first time, do the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="839 282 1139 309">1 Open the your project file.<li data-bbox="839 317 1253 373">2 From the Build menu, select Project settings.<li data-bbox="839 381 1253 437">3 On the Build Options tab, locate the Builder activation section.<li data-bbox="839 446 1253 501">4 Clear the Entity Documentation files and Connect.It DSD files options.<li data-bbox="839 510 968 536">5 Click OK.<li data-bbox="839 545 1089 571">6 Rebuild your project.
Tailoring changes do no appear in web interface because Tomcat does not update cache. [ST26975]	If you are using the Tomcat 4.1.x family of application servers, you should delete the cache in the work folder every time you deploy changes.
Using the Clean the target folders option from the Peregrine Studio Build menu deletes necessary files and folders from the Get-Resources installation. [ST28424]	This option is no longer supported. To recover your deleted files, you will need to redeploy Get-Resources from the installation CD.
