Definitions

Capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this Additional License Authorizations document are defined in the governing Agreement.

Term	Definition
Cold Standby System	means a standby non-production system which is NOT up and running. If the production system breaks down, or needs to be taken out of service, Licensee is required to switch on and start the Cold Standby System in order to take over for the production system.
Concurrent Use	means use by more than one computer at a time, but not to exceed the maximum number of computers as specified in the product documentation.
Development and Test Systems	means a non-production system to be used for a) developing Licensee add-on applications in order to access the licensed Software b) migration testing c) pre-production staging or d) version upgrades/configurations and transition purposes.
E-LTU and E-Media	means products which are electronically delivered only, and as such any references to FOB Destination or delivery methods that are stated on Your purchase order other than electronic shall be null and void with respect to these E-LTU or E-Media products.
Hot Standby System	means a non-production system which is up and running, ready to take over from the production system if the production system breaks down or needs to be taken out of service.

LTU	means License To Use.
Management Console	means only the executables necessary to run the graphical user interface, and which do not require a password to be operational
Management Station	means the complete set of executable modules that make up the Network Node Manager product, and which require a password to be operational.
NNM Node Pack	means a predetermined number of manageable Nodes.
Nodes	means a collection of network interfaces that the Management Station software can pragmatically associate together.
Non-Production or NP	means internal use which is limited to Use on Development and Test Systems and Hot and/or Cold Standby Systems. This NP license requires the previous purchase of the equivalent or greater production licenses. Support for NP licenses is restricted to the period of and current status of the equivalent production license.
Phone Pack	means a collection of IP (Internet Protocol) based phones with an IP Address can be monitored by a Voice over IP management station
Suite	means two or more software products combined into a single license offering. The specific software products included in a Suite are specified in the Software Specific License Terms below. Software products included in a Suite are governed by the individual authorizations and use restrictions associated with each Software Product.
Unlimited Nodes	means that the Management Station Software does not artificially limit to the number of Nodes that can be managed from that instance of the Management Station Software; however, there are practical limits based on overall system resources and performance.

HP Network Node Manager, HP Network Node Manager Advanced

Management Station software products are licensed for use on a single computer. Management Console software products are licensed for Concurrent Use.

A NNM Node Pack License-To-Use (LTU) consists of three components: Management Console, Management Station and Nodes. The reference to Node packs reflects the number of Nodes that can be managed by the Management Station Software and comes in various counts, including, but not limited to: 250, 1000, 5000, and Unlimited Nodes.

Network Node Manager uses several third party applications. For your convenience, these third party applications will be installed during NNM installation. Third party applications are not HP products and are subject to the license terms set forth by their respective companies. You must review and agree to the terms of the licenses before using the third party applications. If you do not agree to the license terms for the third party applications, you may not use the Network Node Manager software.
