Before You Install

Welcome to the WAP Add-in for WinRunner. The WAP Add-in enables you to record and run tests on WAP applications for the Nokia and Phone.com emulators. With the WAP Add-in you can add GUI and bitmap checkpoints to your script to check WAP application properties as well as standard WinRunner properties.

This guide describes how to install Add-in support for WAP objects.



System Requirements

To successfully run WinRunner with the WAP Add-in, you need the following minimum system requirements:

The WAP Add-in setup program installs the WAP Add-in in your WinRunner installation folder.

To install WAP Add-in support:

- 1 Insert the CD-ROM into the drive from which you want to install. If you are installing from a network drive, map the drive.
- 2 Select Run on the Start menu.
- 3 Type the location from which you are installing and setup.exe. For example, type d:\setup.exe.
- 4 In the Registration Information screen, type your name, the name of your company, and a WinRunner maintenance number. This number can be found in the Maintenance Pack Number envelope or on the bill of lading you received when you purchased WinRunner. Note that there is a single maintenance number for each team of users. The maintenance number replaces what was formerly a serial number for each purchased copy of WinRunner. The maintenance number, which identifies the customer, determines how many licenses are generated.

Click Next.

5 Click **Yes** to confirm the registration information.

6 Specify the folder in which to install the WAP Add-in. The destination folder must be the WinRunner installation folder. If the installation folder that appears is not the WinRunner installation folder, click **Browse** to find the correct destination folder.



Click Next.

7 Clear the check box if you do not want to install support for the Nokia WAP application.



Click Next.

8 Select the program folder for the WAP Add-in icons.

Click **Next**. The installation process begins. To pause or quit the installation, click Cancel.

- **9** When the WAP Add-in Installation is complete, remove any disks from their drives.
 - If you installed Nokia support, choose to restart your computer. Click Finish.
 - If you did not install Nokia support, choose whether you want to see the Readme file. Click **Finish**.



Loading the WinRunner WAP Add-in



To start WinRunner with support for WAP applications, select **Programs > WinRunner > WinRunner** from the **Start** menu. The Add-in Manager dialog box opens. Select **WAP** and click **OK**.

If multiple supported WAP emulators are installed on your machine, the WAP Environment dialog box opens. You are prompted to choose a WAP emulator to work with in the current session. Click **OK**.

Tip: If you select the **Don't show this dialog box again** check box, you can choose to display this dialog box in the future by setting the SHOW_WAP_DLG parameter to "1" in the *wrun.ini* file.

Note:

If the Add-In Manager dialog box does not open:

- 1 Start WinRunner.
- 2 In Settings > General Options > Environment tab, check Show Add-in Manager dialog for _____ seconds and fill in a comfortable amount of time in seconds. (The default is 10 seconds).
- 3 Click OK.
- 4 Close WinRunner. A WinRunner Message dialog opens asking "Would you like to save changes made in the configuration?" Click **Yes**.
- 5 When you open WinRunner again, the The Add-in Manager dialog box opens. Select **WAP** and click **OK**.



If you decide not to use WAP support, you can disable the WAP add-in.

To disable the add-in support:

- 1 Select **Programs > WinRunner > WinRunner** from the **Start** menu to open WinRunner.
- 2 After the opening screen appears, the Add-In Manager dialog box opens for ten seconds. (If the Add-In Manager dialog box does not open, follow the instructions in the note on page 13.)

To disable WAP support, clear the **WAP** check box.

3 Click OK. WinRunner opens with the add-in support disabled.
