This release of Connect-It introduces a new connector that allows HP Service Anywhere to integrate with any other on-premise HP products or with third-party products previously supported by Connect-It. This connector is enabled together with the default connector entitlement.

- HP Universal CMDB
 Connect-It now supports HP Universal CMDB 10.01. When used in conjunction with the new HP
 Service Anywhere connector, a complete UDM model-based integration can be performed.
 Note: The connector is limited to the uCMDB 9 API; as such, it cannot presently utilize the latest features that were introduced in uCMDB 10.
- HP Service Manager Connect-It now supports HP Service Manager version 9.31.
