



Service Test 11.50 Installation QuickStart Sheet

This sheet explains the steps to perform a basic installation of Service Test. Complete details on all elements of the Service Test installation can be found in the *HP Service Test Installation Guide*.

Before You Install

- ▶ **Upgrading:** If you are moving from a version of Service Test later than 10.00, the installation process automatically uninstalls your old version of Service Test and install Service Test 11.50.
- ▶ **Silent Installation:** Service Test supports the MSI silent installation mechanism. For details, see the *HP Service Test Installation Guide*.

Installation Instructions

1 Prerequisites:

- ▶ Make sure you have administrator privileges on the drive to which you are installing Service Test (must be a local drive). If you problems installing, you may need to adjust other Windows settings.
- ▶ Know what type of license you are using. If you are using a concurrent license, have the license server URL available.

2 Start the installation.

When the startup screen opens, select **Service Test Setup**. (If the startup screen does not automatically run, enter the following path in the command line: <DVD drive/>setup.exe.)

3 Follow the on-screen instructions.

While you Install

Custom Setup Screen:

If you want to run but not edit Service Test tests, select only the **HP Service Test Runtime** option.

Additional Installation Requirements Screen

If your network requires special DCOM settings, clear the **Configure DCOM Settings** option. For details on manual configuration of the DCOM settings, see the *HP Service Test Installation Guide*.
