General

The RUM HTTP agent does not support http traffic generated via Internet Explorer 9.0 or above (QCCR1I71219).

Upgrade

When upgrading to Real User Monitor version 9.21 from Real User Monitor versions earlier than 9.20, previously saved poor request data is dropped and is no longer available (QCCR1I71259).

RUM Engine 8.07 cannot be upgraded to RUM Engine 9.21 directly (QCCR1I79624).

Workaround: Either upgrade to RUM version 9.13 or 9.20 before upgrading to RUM 9.21, or create a new database schema as part of the RUM 9.21 installation.

Workaround: In IE, view the HP Real User Monitor online Help system in Compatibility View.
