Introduction

The Content Upgrade Utility (CUU) is a tool that extracts specified content from an existing HP OO 9.x repository, and upgrades the extracted content into a content pack that can be deployed in HP OO 10.01.

During the content upgrade process, the CUU exclude HP OO out-of-the-box content from the upgrade. Since SM content is not supplied out-of-the-box, follow this procedure to get the CUU to recognize SM content as partner content and exclude it from the upgrade process.

After the content upgrade is done, deploy the oo10-sm-cp-1.0.0.jar before deploying the upgraded content pack.

Working with CUU on an HP OO Central installation

1. Unzip the oo10-sm-cp-1.0.0_oo10cuu-plugins.zip to a temporary folder on your file system (for example, C:\Temp)
2. From the temporary folder, copy the file oo10-sm-cp-1.0.0_uuids.txt and oo10-sm-deprecated-cp_invalid.txt to the following location:
 - Windows: <OO Installation Directory>\central\cmu\exclusions
 - Linux: <OO Installation Directory>/central/cmu/exclusions

Before you copy please verify if there is an older version of the file and delete it.

3. From the temporary folder, copy the file oo10-sm-cp-1.0.0_Conversions.properties to the following location:
 - Windows: <OO Installation Directory>\central\cmu\plugin-mappings
 - Linux: <OO Installation Directory>/central/cmu/plugin-mappings

Before you copy please verify if there is an older version of the file and delete it.

4. From the temporary folder, copy the file oo10-sm-cp-1.0.0_plugin2op.properties to the following location:
 - Windows: <OO Installation Directory>\central\cmu\plugin2op_mappings
 - Linux: <OO Installation Directory>/central/cmu/ plugin2op_mappings
5. Before you copy please verify if there is an older version of the file and delete it. CUU is ready to recognize the SM content.

Working with CUU on an HP OO Studio installation

1. Unzip the oo10-sm-cp-1.0.0_oo10cuu-plugins.zip to a temporary folder on your file system (for example, C:\Temp)
2. From the temporary folder, copy the file oo10-sm-cp-1.0.0_uuids.txt and oo10-sm-deprecated-cp_invalid.txt to the following location:
 - Windows: <OO Installation Directory>\studio\cmu\exclusions
 - Linux: <OO Installation Directory>/studio/cmu/exclusions

Before you copy please verify if there is an older version of the file and delete it.

3. From the temporary folder, copy the file oo10-sm-cp-1.0.0_Conversions.properties to the following location:
 - Windows: <OO Installation Directory>\studio\cmu\plugin-mappings
 - Linux: <OO Installation Directory>/studio/cmu/plugin-mappings

Before you copy please verify if there is an older version of the file and delete it.

4. From the temporary folder, copy the file oo10-sm-cp-1.0.0_plugin2op.properties to the following location:
