Upgrading the HP Anywhere Server to 10.11

Notes:

- You must upgrade directly from HP Anywhere 10.10. For details, see the HP Anywhere Installation, Configuration, and Upgrade Guide on the Developer Zone.
- You must have administrator privileges on the server machine to upgrade the HP Anywhere Server.
- If you installed a patch over HP Anywhere 10.10, you cannot uninstall the patch after upgrading to 10.11. To uninstall a patch after upgrading, you must first uninstall the upgrade to 10.11 (Start > All Programs > HP > HP Anywhere > Uninstall HP Anywhere 10.11).
- **Important:** It is recommended to make a backup copy of your HPA_HOME (HP Anywhere installation) directory and save it to a different location before starting the upgrade.

To upgrade the HP Anywhere server, do the following on every server node:

- 1. Prerequisites:
 - a. RestBeans.xml is overwritten during the upgrade. If your earlier HP Anywhere 10.0x version used a customized RestBeans.xml, save a copy of <HPA_ HOME>\tomcat\webapps\diamond\WEB-INF\classes\META-INF\cxf\RestBeans.xml. (You will apply the customized configurations to the new RestBeans.xml file after the upgrade.)
 - b. If you customized your Log4j settings (for example, by editing the log level for an appender), you may want to back up the <HP_Anywhere_installation_ directory>/conf/log/ee-log4j.xml prior to upgrading.
- 2. Run the installation wizard:
 - a. Do one of the following:
 - If you are upgrading from the download, extract the installation folder (HP_Anywhere_ 10.11.zip) and run HP_Anywhere_10.11_setup.exe.
 - If you are upgrading from the DVD, click HP Anywhere10.11 Setup.
 - b. In the Introduction page, click Next.
 - c. In the License Agreement page, select I accept the terms of the License Agreement.

d. Click **Next**. The system checks disk space and verifies that HP Anywhere 10.10 is installed. Click **Next**.



e. In the Pre-Install Summary page, click Install.

3. In the Configuration Wizard that opens:

- a. In the Introduction screen, click Next.
- In the Update HP Anywhere Management Database screen, enter the administrator user name and password that you use to access your HP Anywhere database server. (For Oracle, the user name is your **Schema** name.)

Click Next. The database is updated to support the current version.

- c. In the Summary screen, click Finish to close the wizard.
- 4. If you performed the prerequisites in step 1:
 - If you saved a copy of the RestBeans.xml file, apply your customizations to the newly created <HPA_HOME>\tomcat\webapps\diamond\WEB-INF\classes\META-INF\cxf\RestBeans.xml file.
 - If you backed up customized Log4j settings, apply your customizations to the <HP_ Anywhere_installation_directory>/conf/log/ee-log4j.xml file.
- (Optional) Black/White Lists. If your database schema was created for a version prior to HP Anywhere 10.10, you never implemented a black or white list on this server, and you plan to use a black or white list, do the following:.
 - Connect to the HP Anywhere database schema and run one of the following Create SQL commands according to your database type:

- **Oracle:** <HP_Anywhere_installation_folder>\confwizard\conf\scripts\ database\oracle\oracle_create_provisioning_entities.sql
- **MSSQL:** <HP_Anywhere_installation_folder>\confwizard\conf\scripts\ database\mssql\mssql_create_provisioning_entities.sql
- b. Set the **Black/White List** settings in the Administrator Console:
 - i. Log in to the HP Anywhere Administrator Console (http(s)://<HP_Anywhere Server_URL>:<port>/admin).
 - ii. Click the Settings tab.
 - iii. Scroll to the Black/White List section and set
 - Activate Black/White List to True
 - List Type to Black or White
