SAP Installer

The SAP Installer is a cumulative solution for three major components: SAP Content Pack, SAP Wizard and Documentation. When the installer is running, the three options mentioned above will be prompted and the user can choose between them. When the installer is done, the chosen components are installed at the specified location.

The SAP Installer has a new and modern design, consistent with the HP Operations Orchestration installer 10.x version.

SAP CP: the Invoke SAP BAPI description applies to OO 9.x version {QCCR8C23753}	The Invoke SAP BAPI description should be as follows: Before using this operation, follow the steps described below: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="597 789 1391 919">1. Download the SAP Java Connector (JCo) from the SAP Service Marketplace at http://service.sap.com/connectors.
