Question	When is HP discontinuing License Infrastructure Manager?	
Answer	Effective September 1, 2014, HP is announcing the discontinuance of License Infrastructure Manager. Current customers may continue to purchase additional licenses of License Infrastructure Manager until November 1, 2014. As of this date, the product will be removed from HP's Corporate Price List and will no longer be orderable.	
Question	What product numbers are affected by this obsolescence?	
Answer	Please refer to Appendix B in the customer letter for the list of affected product numbers.	
Question	When is the last date I can order License Infrastructure Manager?	
Answer	License Infrastructure Manager will continue to be available for purchase to current support customers through November 1, 2014. As of that date, you will no longer be able to purchase additional licenses of the product.	
Question	Can I still purchase additional licenses for License Infrastructure Manager? If yes, how?	
Answer	Additional licenses may not be purchased for versions that are discontinued and past their end of sale date.	
Question	Is the LIM functionality available in any other HP products?	
Answer	Yes, the LIM will now be available as a part of the installation package for WebInspect 10.20 and newer.	
Question	Who can I contact if I have more questions with regards to this product discontinuance?

Question	Should there be a defect with a version of License Infrastructure Manager for which no defect fixing is done anymore, can I pay for a fix to be implemented on my request?	
Answer	HP may choose to offer defect fixes at a premium price, depending on available resources.
