New Features in this Release

OMi MP for Vertica works with OMi and enables you to monitor Vertica cluster databases operating in a Big Data environment using the Business Service Management (BSM). It contains the following features:

- Management Templates for a complete management solution of Vertica databases. It consists of aspects for monitoring the availability, health, and performance of Vertica database environments.
- Aspects comprising of policy templates for monitoring Vertica clusters.

- Parameterized artifacts for easy customization and deployment.
- Configuration Item (CI) based configuration and deployment.

Installation Notes

The OMi MP for Vertica is available in the electronic media (e-media). The OMi MP for Vertica e-media contains the software and the product documentation. You can use the e-media to install the OMi MP for Vertica on BSM and OMi (Linux or Windows) Servers.

Known Problems and Workarounds

Title: BSM help does not appear.

Description: BSM Online Help does not appear due to incompatibility between BSM Help and OMi Management Pack Help in the following scenarios:

- When a BSM 9.2x system with OMi Management Pack for Vertica already installed is upgraded to BSM 9.25
- Or
- When OMi Management Pack for Vertica is installed on a BSM 9.25 system

Solution: To resolve this problem, install the **BSM 9.25 patch for OMi Management Pack** by following these steps:

1. Launch the HPE Software Support - <https://softwaresupport.hpe.com> and Sign in.
2. Click **Search**.
3. Select the relevant product, version and operation system (for example, Application Performance Management (BAC) > 9.25 > Windows).
4. Under **Document Type**, select **Patches**.
5. Locate the **BSM 9.25 patch for OMi Management Pack**.

Title: You are unable to launch tools from the CI.

Title: After setting the Java path in PATH and JAVA_HOME environment variables, you must restart Operations agent.

Workaround: None.

Title: Dependent parameters do not appear sometimes after you deploy the Vertica Management Template

Description: After you deploy the Vertica Management Template, the dependent parameters do not appear sometimes for further tuning under Assignments and Tuning.

Workaround: To resolve this problem, edit the parameters at the Aspect level for the corresponding Management Template. For more information, see **QCCR1A162664**.
