QCCR1E117249	The customer has a simple CIT mail scenario to send mails from HP Service Manager to an ESMTP server. The following warning message is received when the customer has a large group of recipients: "Sun-Java-System-SMTP-Warning: Lines longer than SMTP allows found and truncated."	This defect is fixed by code change.
		The maximum line number allowed by Connect-It is 1000. Now, if the text length exceeds this number, a carriage return will be inserted automatically.

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CR	Problem	Solution
QCCR1E117292	If the separator for date/time fields in SM is different from "/" (for example, a dot), the value is not retrieved by CIT. Instead, a Null value is returned.	This defect is fixed by code change. Connect-It now supports "/" as a date/time separator now.
QCCR1E118680	After the Connect-It service runs for a period of time, it fails to connect to Service Anywhere.	This defect is fixed by code change. After a session expires, Connect-It now releases the resource before logging on again, thus avoiding the connection failure.
QCCR1E119272	The customer uses Connect-It Email fetching connector to read the emails. However, the email body returns empty string. This issue occurs when the email contains directive: Content-Disposition. It is not properly parsed by Connect-IT.	This defect is fixed by code change. Connect-It now parses IMAP correctly and all contents can be returned.
QCCR1E119794	Exported Japanese characters are unreadable.	In mapping script, Connect-It does not support setting a code page when reading from a file, it only uses UTF-8 or Unicode for encoding. When the file is Japanese code page, the issue occurs. Now Connect-It provides a basic function named SetFileCodePage (iFileDesc, strCodePageName) in basic script for the customers to set the code page.

QCCR1E120836	Since the time change on Oct 26,2014, the mail-header pushed from Connect-IT still shows the summer time.	This defect is fixed by a code change. Connect-It now shows the summer time correctly.
QCCR1E121052	The MaaS connector fails to connect to SAW in the schedule mode. QCCR1E121211	When using CIT 9.60 email sending connector, there are no line breaks in the email. This problem does not occur in earlier versions.	This defect is fixed by code change. The line breaks now works correctly.
QCCR1E121769	There are no CIT scenarios for the integration between AM9.50 and SM9.40, like ESS-Catalog and PPT.	AM9.50-SM9.40 scenarios are added.
