This document provides an overview of the HP Operations Orchestration Cloud content pack 1.5.1 release. It contains important information that is not included in the manuals or in the online help.

This release supports the following languages:

## What's New

- **New supported versions**

Support for the following new version has been added:

- HP Helion Eucalyptus 4.x

- **Amazon Signature Version 4:**

- A new operation, **Compute Signature V4**, has been added under */Library/Integrations/Amazon/S3/Utilities/*. This operation supports the signature version 4 algorithm and provides a way for the user to specify all the inputs required by the signature calculation algorithm.
  - The **Compute Signature**, **Process Headers**, **Compute Signature** and **Add Authorization Header** steps from flows in the **Buckets** and **Objects** folders have been updated in order to work with signature V4.
- **OpenStack Object Storage - Update Container:** The functionality to update a container has been added. This includes operations such as enabling versioning, synchronization, making items public etc.
  - **OpenStack Block Storage - Extend/Reduce Volume Size:** A new flow, **Resize Volume** has been added under */Library/Integrations/OpenStack/Block Storage/Volumes/*. This flow allows you to resize an OpenStack volume using the volume ID and the new size.
  - A new flow, **Get Bucket Location**, has been added under */Library/Integrations/Amazon/S3/Buckets/*. This flow is used to determine a bucket's location constraints.
  - **Eucalyptus:** Eucalyptus API is now compatible with Amazon. AWS.OO OOTB contains flows for provisioning AWS resources.

## Enhancements

- The **Compute Signature**, **Process Headers**, and **Add Authorization Header** steps from flows under */Library/Integrations/Amazon/S3/Objects/Compute Signature/Objects* have been updated to work with signature V4.
- The **Multipart File Upload** flow under */Library/Integrations/Amazon/S3/Objects/* has been enhanced to support chunked upload. In addition all the steps that the signature V4 algorithm requires in order to accomplish this upload method have been updated.
- A new input, **serviceEndpoint**, was added to the **Enumerate Regions** operation under */Library/Integrations/Amazon/EC2/Availability Zones and Regions/*. This input now allows you to provide a specific endpoint for the **Enumerate Regions** operation.
- The operations in the **Security Groups** folder have been enhanced to support security groups in a non-default VPC, which are part of Amazon's EC2-VPC functionality. All the operations support the Security Group ID needed to reference this type of security group.
- A new input, **vpclId**, was added to the **Create Security Group** operation under */Library/Integrations/Amazon/EC2/Security Groups/*.
- The table in the output **returnResult** has been enhanced with new **group id** and **group's vpc id** columns in the **Describe Security Groups** operations under */Library/Integrations/Amazon/EC2/Security Groups/*.
- The **Modify Instance Attribute** operation under */Library/Integrations/Amazon/EC2/Instances/* was enhanced with 16 new inputs in order to be aligned with the Amazon API.

## Deploying the OO Cloud Content Pack

OO platform versions 10.00 and later support Cloud Content Pack 1.5.1. However, it is recommended to deploy the Cloud Content Pack 1.5.1 on an existing OO platform version of 10.21.0001 or later.

For details on deploying a content pack, see "Importing Content Packs to a Project" in the *Studio Authoring Guide* and "Deploying a Content Pack" in the *Central User Guide*.

**Note:** Cloud Content Pack 1.5.1 is dependent on Base Content Pack 1.5.3. Therefore, Base Content Pack 1.5.3 must be deployed before or together with Cloud Content Pack 1.5.1.

## Limitations

### Get Bucket Content

In the **Get Bucket Content** flow under */Library/Integrations/Amazon/S3/Buckets/*, the input values for **marker** and **prefix** must not contain the following characters: '&', '/'.

### Delete Object

The **Delete Object** flow under */Library/Integrations/Amazon/S3/Objects/* may not function correctly when handling objects that have names containing the '~' or '&' characters.

### Upload Folder

The **Upload Folder** flow under */Library/Integrations/Amazon/S3/Objects/* may not function correctly when handling objects that have names containing the ',' (comma) character.
