HP Operations Manager

Data Protector SPI can be installed on the HPOM for Linux 9.xx management server running on the following operating systems:

- RedHat Enterprise Linux 5.x, 6.x 64-bit

HP Operations Agent

Data Protector SPI can be deployed from the HPOM management server to the managed nodes with the installed HP Operations Agent of version 11.11.025 and higher running on the following operating systems:

- Cent OS 6.x 64-bit
- Oracle Enterprise Linux 6.x 64-bit
- RedHat Enterprise Linux 5.x, 6.x 64-bit
- SUSE Linux Enterprise Server 11 64-bit
- Windows Server 2008
- Windows Server 2012

HP Data Protector

Data Protector SPI can be deployed from the HPOM management server to the managed nodes with the installed Data Protector Cell Managers running on the following operating systems:

- Cent OS 6.x 64-bit
- Oracle Enterprise Linux 6.x 64-bit
- RedHat Enterprise Linux 5.x, 6.x 64-bit
- SUSE Linux Enterprise Server 11 64-bit
- Windows Server 2008
- Windows Server 2012

The supported Data Protector versions are: 7.xx, 8.xx, and 9.0x.
