HP Backup Navigator 9.20 is supported on the following hardware:

Linux

- Required RAM: 8 GB
- Required disk space: 20 GB

Operating System

HP Backup Navigator 9.20 runs on the following operating systems:

- Red Hat Enterprise Linux 6.4/6.6 operating system (Basic Server installation type)

Databases

The following database is required for HP Backup Navigator 9.20

- PostgreSQL 9.3

Web Servers

One of the following supported Web Servers is required to run HP Backup Navigator 9.20:

- Apache Tomcat 7.x

Web Browsers and Plug-ins

One of the following supported web browsers with the following plug-ins is required to run HP Backup Navigator 9.20:

- Internet Explorer 10, 11
- Mozilla Firefox 26 or later versions
- Google Chrome 30 or later versions

Additional Requirements

The following additional software is required to run HP Backup Navigator 9.20:

- OpenJDK 1.7
