What's New

When interacting with a Microsoft Exchange server, use the generic **Powershell** operation under /Library/Operations/Exchange/<version specific> folder, instead of loading the Exchange snap-in to this Powershell Script operation. For more information, see http://www.get-exchange.info/2012/12/30/powershell-scripting-for-exchange-server-some-tips/.

The HP Business Applications content pack now contains additional information that describes which content packs must be deployed along with the Business Applications content pack in order to function properly. The content pack dependency information is visible in HP Operations Orchestration starting with version 10.50.

Deploying the Business Applications Content Pack

OO platform versions 10.00 and later support Business Applications Content Pack 1.3.0. However, it is recommended to deploy the Business Applications Content Pack 1.3.0 on an existing OO platform version of 10.50 or later.

Flows in the Test Exchange folder occasionally do not behave as expected

Depending on the Microsoft Exchange 2013 release version (for example, RTM, SP1, Cumulative Update 6), some API elements (such as Exchange Powershell cmdlets) may not work as expected or may fail when the target host of the operations and flows is an Exchange 2013 server that has only one role installed (either Client Access or Mailbox role but not both).

If the target host of the operations and flows is an Exchange 2013 server with both roles installed (Client Access and Mailbox) then this issue does not apply.

Exchange - Send emails with attachments

The /Library/Operations/Exchange/Emails/Send Email operation cannot send emails with attachments.

Microsoft Exchange 2010 and 2013 Move Mailbox Fails for Valid Inputs

When running the operation with valid inputs, and there are no previous existing move requests for a mailbox on the Microsoft Exchange Server, the operation fails with the message that it cannot find the user identity for the mailbox to be moved.
