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Storage Optimizer Release Notes

New Features in This Release

- It is now possible to evaluate and execute Archive policies on the server that contains the repository to be managed.

Fixed Defects in This Release

- Performance of repository visualization generation has been improved by limiting the default visualization to just “All Content”.
- The Configuration utility now works when run on servers with non-English locales.
- It is now possible to edit an existing repository group.
- Repository analysis now works when a category has been configured to identify Obsolete or Trivial content.

Limitations in This Release

Deletion

- Windows stubs cannot be deleted. You cannot open the stub file, or edit and save it (forced read-only).
- Linux stubs that appear as symbolic links can be deleted as any other symbolic links and are forced read-only.

Renaming

- Windows stubs can be renamed. The target information is in the stub file, so it can be retrieved.
- Linux supports standard stubs, so all operations are supported on it.

Note: Both Windows and Linux skip the encrypted files. However, this is done at the policy level.
