Dear USP-M Customer,

In November 2015, HPE announced the availability of USP-M 4.3 on RHEL7. This new USP-M version improves upon previous USP-M versions, and provides significant breakthrough in customer value through new functionalities.

The release of USP-M 4.3 impacts the End-of-Sale and End-of-Support dates of previous USP-M releases as described below:

End of Sale and End of Support for USP-M 4.2 on RHEL6

USP-M 4.2 on RHEL6 product support will end on December 31, 2019

USP-M 4.2 on RHEL6 will be no longer orderable or available for purchase after Dec 31, 2016.

End of Sale and End of Support for USP-M 4.2 on HPUX 11iv3

USP-M 4.2 on 11iv3 product support will end on April 30, 2021

USP-M 4.2 on 11iv3 will be no longer orderable or available for purchase after April 30, 2016.

Please note that -

- USP-M 4.2 on older HPUX and RHEL OS versions is already end of support.

- Capacity upgrades on USP-M 4.2 (RHEL6/11iv3) will continue to be available up to Dec 2018.

- License purchase would be required for customers migrating from HPUX 11iv3.

- License purchase would not be necessary for customers on USP-M 4.2/ RHEL6 migrating to USP-M 4.3
