Software and Hardware Requirements

Protecting Your Deployment from Security Vulnerabilities

Make sure you take necessary precautions to protect your PPM Center deployment from general security vulnerabilities, especially those related to Web server and related infrastructure vulnerabilities. Patch and configure your Web server's operating system and DNX servers to prevent malicious attacks that could put your organization and data at risk. You can take such steps as disabling unused ports or enabling SSL in your environment. Consult your Web server vendor for the latest patches to prevent harmful attacks such as cross-site scripting.

Chapter 2: Installation Notes

Note:

- PPM Center 9.32 is required before you apply version 9.32.0003.
- HP recommends you back up your customized files including scripts before applying PPM Center version 9.32.0003.

To install PPM Center version 9.32.0003:

1. Back up your database.
2. Back up your customized data.
3. Stop the PPM Server. The Service Pack cannot be installed on an active server.
4. Copy the Service Pack file `ppm-932-patch0003.jar` to the `<PPM_Home>` directory. This is the directory where the PPM Server is installed.
5. Change to the `<PPM_Home>/bin` directory.
6. Start the installation using the following command:

```
sh ./kDeploy.sh -i patch0003
```
7. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.
8. Start the PPM Server.

Enhancements in Version 9.32.0003

PPM Center version 9.32.0003 includes the following enhancements:

Note: These enhancements introduce several new strings. These strings are not localized in this patch release, displayed in English only.

Committing Selected Resources in Resource Finder

In previous versions, when you assign a resource to a position, the resource status is soft-booked. Starting from 9.32.0003, you can choose to commit assigned resource, that is, when a resource is assigned, the resource status becomes committed automatically.

Do the following to commit resources in resource finder:

1. Set the parameter `ENABLE_COMMIT_RESOURCES_IN_RESOURCE_FINDER` to `true` in Administration Console.

It is `false` by default. Setting the parameter to `true` makes the option **Commit selected resources** available in the resource finder.

2. In the Staffing Profile New UI or Gantt View of Resource Allocations Management page, click the assign icon for a position to open the resource finder.
3. The option **Commit selected resources** appears only when there are resources available in the resource finder.

4. Select the resources to be assigned, and check the option **Commit selected resources**.

If you want this option to be checked by default, set the parameter `CHECK_COMMIT_RESOURCES_IN_RESOURCE_FINDER` to `true` in Administration Console. It is `false` by default. The setting of this parameter is only meaningful when you set the parameter `ENABLE_COMMIT_RESOURCES_IN_RESOURCE_FINDER` to `true`.

5. Click **Assign**.

The status of the assigned resources becomes committed.

Distributing Demand to Selected Resources Evenly in Resource Finder

In previous versions, when you assign resources to a position, PPM allocates the position demand unevenly. It uses up the remaining capacity of the first resource, then the second resource, and goes on until demand is fulfilled. Starting from 9.32.0003, you can distribute demand to the selected resources evenly.

Do the following to distribute demand to resources evenly:

1. Set the parameter `ENABLE_DISTRIBUTE_RESOURCES_IN_RESOURCE_FINDER` to `true` in Administration Console.

It is `false` by default. Setting the parameter to `true` makes the option **Distribute demand evenly to selected resources** available in the resource finder.

2. In the Staffing Profile New UI or Gantt View of Resource Allocations Management page, click the assign icon for a position to open the resource finder.
3. Select at least two resources, and then the option **Distribute demand evenly to selected resources** appears.
4. Check the option **Distribute demand evenly to selected resources**.

If you want this option to be checked by default, set the parameter `CHECK_DISTRIBUTE_RESOURCES_IN_RESOURCE_FINDER` to `true` in Administration Console. It is `false` by default. The setting of this parameter is only meaningful when you set the parameter `ENABLE_DISTRIBUTE_RESOURCES_IN_RESOURCE_FINDER` to `true`.

5. Click **Assign**.

The position demand is distributed evenly to the selected resources, even when it results in over-allocation of some of the resources.

Recording Success Logs for Background Services

Starting from 9.32.0003, you can use the following parameters in Administration Console to enable recording success logs for background services.

Parameter Name	Description	Values
ENABLE_LOG_SUCCESS_SERVICE_LIST	Specify the refernces codes of services. If these services are run successfully, PPM will record the success logs for them. Reference codes are separated by semicolon.	For example: _COST_RATE_RULE_UPDATE_SERVICE; _COST_ROLLUP_SERVICE
SERVICE_RECORDS_EXPIRATION_DAYS	Specify the duration (in days) of the success logs. The log that expire the duration will be removee automatically from the Service Records page.	Default: 14

To view success logs for background services:

1. From the menu, select **Open > Administration > View Service Audit Page**.
2. Click the service for which you have enabled recording success logs.

The Service Records page opens listing all the success logs.
3. Click the detail link to view more details about the log.

Limitation: In 9.32.0003, you can only enable recording success logs for Cost Rate Rule Update Service.

Adding Options in Staffing Tab of Project Overview Page

To facilitate the use of staffing profile in the **Staffing** tab of the Project Overview page, PPM Center 9.32.0002 performs the following changes in the **Staffing** tab:


- Add a header, which includes the following:
 - The staffing profile name
 - The **Change Header** button or the **View Header** button, depending on your access grant
 - The **More** button, which includes the following options:
 - Configure Access
 - Configure Notifications
 - Delete Staffing Profile
 - Staffing Profile Audit Trail
- Add the **Export to Excel** option in the toolbar above the position table.

Note: Some of the buttons and options may not be available depending on your access grant.

Adding Horizontal and Vertical Totals in Staffing Profile New UI

PPM Center 9.32.0002 adds the horizontal and vertical totals in the Table view of the Staffing Profile New UI, as shown below.

The horizontal totals, which include Forecast Total (displayed in black) and Unmet Total (displayed in orange), are added at the end of the position table.

The vertical total is Total Hours, Average FTE, or Total Days, depending on the display view. If the position table is in the Hours view, the Total Hours column is displayed. If the position table is in the FTE view, the Average FTE column is displayed. If the position table is in the Person Days view, the Total Days column is displayed.

Enhancements on Specifying Requested Resources for Positions

PPM Center 9.32.0002 implements the following enhancements on specifying resources for positions:

- The Specific Resources Requested column becomes a default column in staffing profile.
- In inline-edit mode, if you select only one resource that belongs to different resource pools in different periods, a window pops up asking you to select a resource pool for the requested resource.

The Resource Pool column is filled with the resource pool you select. The Resource Type and Cost Category columns are filled with the resource's type and cost category respectively.

- In inline-edit mode, if you select more than one resource, the Resource Pool, Resource Type, and Cost Category columns will not be updated or filled with the resources' attributes.

Filtering Positions by Unmet Demand and Over-allocation in Staffing Profile New UI

Starting from 9.32.0002, you can filter positions by unmet demand and over-allocation in Staffing Profile New UI. Clicking the Filter icon opens the filters.

The following table describes the unmet demand and over-allocation filters.

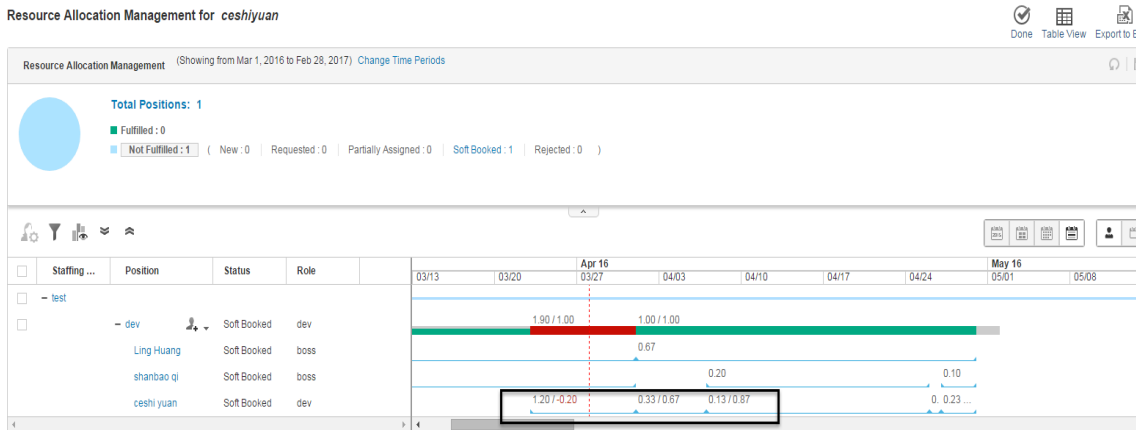
Filter	Description
Unmet Demand no less than	Filters the positions whose unmet demands are equal to or greater than the number of FTE you specified.
Over Allocation no less than	Filters the positions whose over-allocations are equal to or greater than the number of FTE you specified.
From_To_	The time range when unmet demand or over-allocation occurs. These two filters are enabled only when you select the Unmet Demand no less than or Over Allocation no less than checkbox. By default, the time range is the same as that of the staffing profile.

Displaying Resource Remaining Capacity

Starting from 9.32.0002, the following pages display the resource remaining capacity for each assigned resource:

- Gantt view of Resource Allocation Management page
- Staffing Profile New UI (both Gantt view and Table view)

The following is an example of how resource remaining capacity is displayed in the Gantt view of Resource Allocation Management page and Gantt view of Staffing Profile New UI.



Take "1.20/-0.20" for example. "1.20" is the resource allocation, while "-0.20" is the resource remaining capacity. If the resource is over-allocated, the remaining capacity is a negative value displayed in red.

The resource remaining capacity in the Table view of Staffing Profile New UI is displayed in the same way, except that if the resource is over-allocated, the resource remaining capacity is a positive value displayed in red.

Limitation

When a resource is assigned to two positions of a staffing profile and you edit the resource allocation in one of the position, the resource remaining capacity gets updated only in the position you are editing. You have to refresh the page to get the resource remaining capacity updated in both positions.

Not Sending Resource Requests for Positions of Certain Statuses

Starting from 9.32.0002, resource requests for the following positions are not sent any longer in the Staffing Profile New UI:

- Requested positions
- Fulfilled positions
- Softbooked positions that have zero unmet demand

Though you can still select these positions to have them listed in the Send Resource Requests window, there are no checkboxes in front of them. Therefore, clicking **Send** in the Send Resource Requests window will not send resource requests for these positions.

Easier Way to Enter Efforts for Positions

Starting from 9.32.0002, you can do the following to copy and paste efforts for positions in the same row in the Table view of the Staffing Profile New UI:

1. Select a cell to copy.
2. Use **SHIFT + click** to fill a range of other cells in the same row with the value.

Note: These enhancements introduce several new strings, for example, the **Check All** option in the enhancement ["Able to Select All Resources in Assign Resource Dialog" on page 16](#). These strings are not localized in this patch release, displayed in English only.

Preventing Data Loss Due to Inactivity in Request Details, Project Details, and Edit Time Sheet pages

You might spend long time entering data in pages like Edit Time Sheet page and Project Details page. However, PPM would regard this as inactivity and then terminate your session. This causes inconvenience because you have to start all over again.

Starting from version 9.32.0001, PPM introduces the following two parameters for you to specify the duration you can stay idle in the Request Details page, Project Details page, and Edit Time Sheet page. This helps prevent data loss because of inactivity in these pages.

Parameter	Description, Usage	Values
REQUEST_AND_PROJECT_KEEPALIVE_MAX_IDLE_TIME	You use this parameter to specify the duration (in minutes) that you can stay idle on the Request Details page and Project Details page before your session starts to time out.	Default value: 600 Valid value: integer
TIMESHEET_KEEPALIVE_MAX_IDLE_TIME	You use this parameter to specify the duration (in minutes) that you can stay idle on the Edit Time Sheet page before your session starts to time out.	Default value: 180 Valid value: integer

The `KINTANA_SESSION_TIMEOUT` parameter, which specifies the time to elapse before a user session times out, still takes effect when you use the above two parameters. They work together in the following way:

- When `REQUEST_AND_PROJECT_KEEPALIVE_MAX_IDLE_TIME` and `TIMESHEET_KEEPALIVE_MAX_IDLE_TIME` have values greater than 0, you can stay idle in the Request Details page, Project Details page, and Edit Time Sheet page for the specified duration. After the duration ends, the session times out when the time specified by `KINTANA_SESSION_TIMEOUT` is up.

In this case, as long as you are not idle in these pages performing actions like clicking the mouse and pressing keys, your session will not time out because PPM keeps the session alive.

- When the value of `REQUEST_AND_PROJECT_KEEPALIVE_MAX_IDLE_TIME` is 0, `KINTANA_SESSION_TIMEOUT` works in the Request Details page and Project Details page as it does in other PPM pages: your session times out if no requests are sent from the browser to the server for a duration equal to or greater than the `KINTANA_SESSION_TIMEOUT` value.

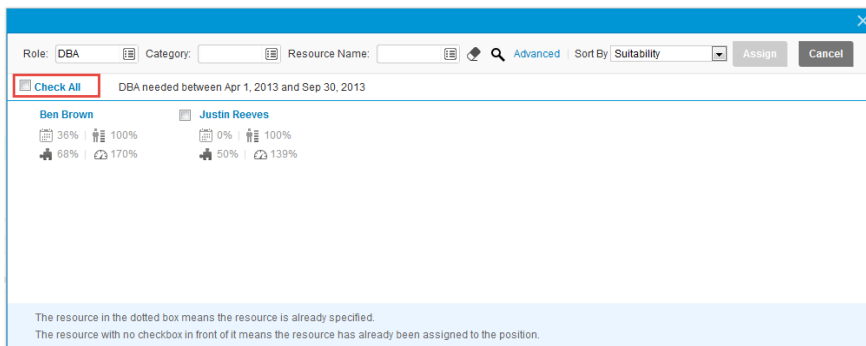
- When the value of `TIMESHEET_KEEPALIVE_MAX_IDLE_TIME` is 0, `KINTANA_SESSION_TIMEOUT` works in the Edit Time Sheet page as it does in other PPM pages: your session times out if no requests are sent from the browser to the server for a duration equal to or greater than the `KINTANA_SESSION_TIMEOUT` value.

Hiding User Data Fields in Staffing Profile New UI

If you set the description of a user data field to be started with an exclamation mark (!), the user data field displays the value behind "!" as the field name. Therefore, when you set the description of the user data field to "!" with nothing followed, the user data field is hidden in the staffing profile page. If the user data field has a value, only the value is visible.

Able to Select All Resources in Assign Resource Dialog

Starting from version 9.32.0001, the **Check All** option is available in the assign resource dialog in the Staffing Profile New UI.



- Checking this option, you select all the displayed resources. However, the resources that are only displayed when you click **More** are not selected.
- If you check this option and then deselect some resources, this option is still checked. In this case, only the selected resources will be assigned.
- Not checking this option, you deselect all the resources.

Generating Java Dumps

PPM Center 9.32.0001 provides the following two simple ways for you to generate Java dumps (heap

dumps and thread dumps):

Note: Java dumps can be generated for started PPM server only.

- Using the command `sh .\kGenJavaDump.sh`
 - a. Change to the `<PPM_Home>/bin` directory.
 - a. Run the command: `sh .\kGenJavaDump.sh`.
- Using the Administration Console
 - a. Log on to PPM Center.
 - b. From the menu item, select **Open > Administration > Open Administration Console**.
 - c. Select **Support Task > Generate Java Dumps**.
 - d. Click **Generate**.

The generated Java dumps are collected in the `<PPM_HOME>\bin\support\javadumps` folder:

- The heap dump files are in the following format:
`<NODE_NAME>_<PID>_<TIMESTAMP>_heap.hprof`
- The thread dump files are in the following format:
`<NODE_NAME>_<PID>_<TIMESTAMP>_thread.hprof`

Viewing Resource Pool Assignable Resources when Forwarding Requests

Starting from version 9.32.0001, as a resource manager, you can view the resource availability of any resource pool when forwarding requests. This helps make sure that you forward requests to effective resource pools that have assignable resources.

This enhancement is implemented to Forward request to another pool window opened from either of the following two pages:


- Staffing Profile New UI
- Gantt view of Resource Allocation Management page

To view resource availability of a resource pool when forwarding requests:


1. From the Staffing Profile page or the Resource Allocation Management page, open the Forward request to another pool window for a demanded position.

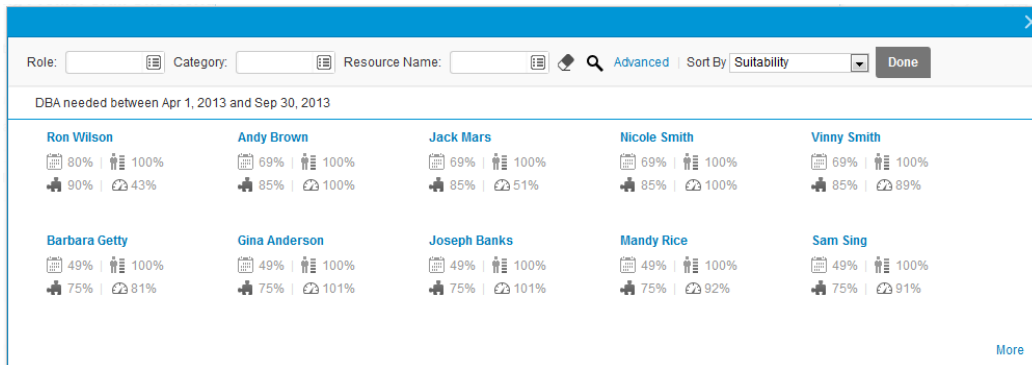

2. In the Forward to Resource Pool field, specify a resource pool. The icon  is enabled.

3. Click the icon . The resource query page opens, displaying all the assignable resources in the resource pool you specified.



You can use the Role, Category, Resource Name, and Sort By fields to filter the resources.

4. To check the assignable resources in other resource pools, you can do one of the following:
 - o Click **Done** to close the resource query window and go back to the Forward request to another pool window, and then repeat from step 2 to step 3.
 - o Use the Assignable Resources window.
 - i. Click **Advanced**. The Assignable Resources window opens in the Resource Results tab, which displays more details of assignable resources.
 - ii. Click the **Modify Search Criteria** tab.
 - iii. In the Resource Pool field, select another resource pool or multiple other resource pools you want to check.
 - iv. Click **Search**. The Resource Results tab display the assignable resources in the resource pool (or resource pools).
 - v. Click **Done** to close the Assignable Resources window and go back to the Forward request to another pool window.

Display Enhancement to Overall Status section of Project Overview Page

In previous sections, the Overall Status section of the Project Overview page is stretched across the screen when there are multiple project managers assigned for the project.

Starting from version 9.32.001, the project managers names are truncated when they exceed 80 characters. The full list of project managers names are shown in a tooltip when you put your mouse over the names. This helps avoid the page layout overflow issue.


Sorting Resources by Full Name Alphabetically in Assign Resource Window

PPM Center version 9.32.0001 enables you to sort resources by full name alphabetically in the assign resource window from the Staffing Profile New UI.

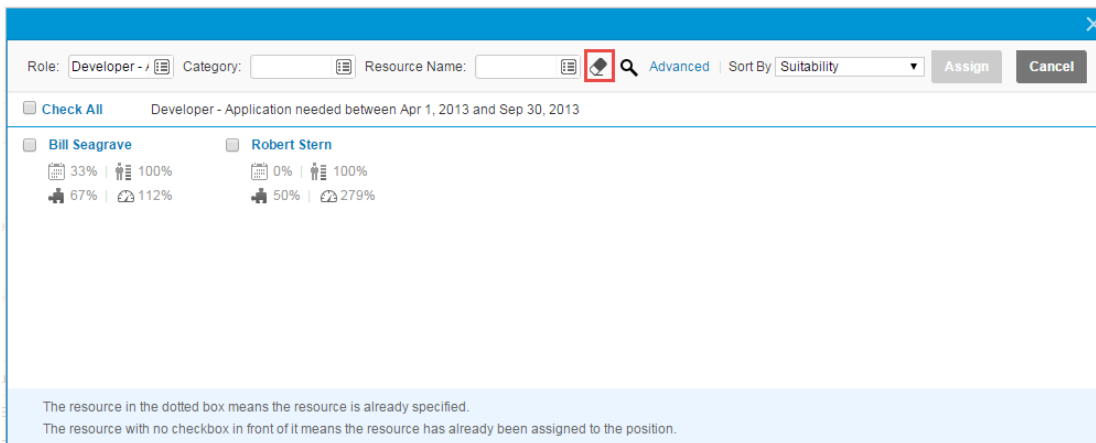
1. In the Staffing Profile New UI, click the Assign icon to open the assign resource window.
2. From the Sort By drop-down list, select **Resource Name**.

The resources in the assign resource window are sorted by full name alphabetically.

Clearing All Filters in Assign Resource Window

The Clear Filter icon () is added in the following windows:

- Assign resource window, opened from the Staffing Profile New UI and the Gantt View of the Resource Allocation Management page.
- Resource query window, which is used to view assignable resources in a resource pool. See "[Viewing Resource Pool Assignable Resources when Forwarding Requests](#)" on page 17.



Clicking this icon clears all the filters in the window. If you click the icon, the window refreshes with the update results only when you click the Search icon.

Integrations

Problem: You cannot use "@task_name" to search tasks in the Integration Configurations > Hybrid Project page.

Workaround: None.

HP Resource Management

Problem: If a position does not have forecast demand and you send resource request, the position still shows unmet demand when a resource is assigned to the position.

Workaround: None.

Note: This known issue has been fixed by QCCR1L60709 in 9.32.0003.

Problem: In IE 11 and Firefox, the input fields in the Create a New Role page are too close to each other.

Workaround: None.

Chapter 6: Documentation Errata

The following documentation items are incorrect.

Installation and Administration Guide

The License Install page does not have Submit button but the Install button

Location: *Installation and Administration Guide*, version 9.30

Error: The *Installation and Administration Guide* states the following:

"On the License Install page, click Browse to locate the license file you saved, and then click Submit."

However, there is only an "Install" button instead of a "Submit" button.

Correction: Change the button name from "Submit" to "Install" in the "Installing Autopass License Key File and Viewing License Summary in Administration Console" section of the guide.

HP Resource Management User's Guide

The information is missing that you do not get notifications if sending request to your own resource pool

Location: *HP Resource Management User's Guide*, version 9.30

Error: If you are the resource pool manager and send resource request to your own resource pool, you will not receive email notifications. This information is not added in the PPM guides.

Correction: Add the following in the "Modifying Resource Pool Notifications" section of the guide:

If you are the resource pool manager and send resource requests to your own resource pool, you will not receive email notification.

Need to explain why users assigned to a staffing profile or work plan cannot view the staffing profile

Location: *HP Resource Management User's Guide*, version 9.30

Error: The guide does not explain the situation where users assigned to a staffing profile or work plan cannot view the staffing profile.

Correction: The "Staffing Profile Security" section in the Resource Management User's Guide should add the following information:

When users who are assigned to tasks in the work plan or who are specified on the staffing profile itself only have the View Staffing Profiles access grant, they still need to be added to the Configure Access page. Otherwise, they cannot view the project staffing profile.

RESTful Web Services Guide

Missing the information getRequests service returns at most 1,000 requests

Location: *RESTful Web Services Guide*, version 9.20 and 9.30

Error: The guide does not include the limitation that the getRequests service returns at most 1,000 requests of a certain type.

Correction: Add the following limitation in the Getting Requests of a Certain Type section of the guide:

This RESTful web service returns at most 1,000 requests of a certain type.

Release Notes

Inaccurate instructions about installing PPM 9.31 extensions for Oracle Apps

Location: *Release Notes*, version 9.31

Error: The instructions about installing HP Deployment Management Extension for Oracle E-Business Suite version 9.31 in the release notes include inaccurate information.

Correction: Update the step 6.b and step 6.c in the release notes as follows:

- b. If PPM is not installed in the same database as Oracle Apps (hosting OM/GLM), select **N** for the question "Does this database include the Oracle Apps install where OM/GLM will run?". Otherwise, select **Y**.
 - c. If Oracle Apps (hosting OM/GLM) is installed in a different database than PPM, select **Y** for the question "Is Oracle Apps (hosting OM/GLM) installed in a different database?". Otherwise, select **N**.

HP Project Management User's Guide

Add the permissions related to stakeholders on Project Details page

Location: *HP Project Management User's Guide*, version 9.30

Error: The permissions related to stakeholders on project details page should be added to the guide.

Correction: Add the following in the Entering Project Details section of the guide:

When a request type is associated with a project type as the project process request type, PPM checks the following conditions:

- Whether or not stakeholders have the permission to view the request type.
- Whether or not stakeholders have the permission to edit projects or have the right to override project type settings.
- Whether or not stakeholders have the permission to edit the request type.

For stakeholders who only have the View All Projects access grant, they have the right to override project type settings. Therefore, they can edit all fields in the Project Details tab.

For stakeholders who only have the View Project access grant, they do not have the right to override project type settings. Therefore, they cannot edit fields in the Project Details tab.
