This document provides an overview of HPE Database and Middleware Automation Premium and Express Edition Capsules (HPE DMA) for the 10.50.000.000 release. There are no Fixed Issues or Enhancement Requests included in these Release Notes.

Release Highlights

HPE Database and Middleware Premium Edition (DMA Premium) and Express Edition (DMA Express) enable DBaaS and PaaS services using HPE Cloud Service Automation (CSA) and HPE Operations Orchestration (OO). The DMA Premium - Database and DMA Express - Database service designs simplify and accelerate the creation of the Database lifecycle service design and implementation so that it can be consumed more easily by multiple business users and managed more quickly and consistently by database administrators.

About Content Capsules

HPE CSA Content Capsules include new content and functionality for HPE CSA that can be added independent of platform releases. These contents and functionality consist primarily of resource offerings, service designs, HPE OO flows, and documentation.

Requirements

This implementation requires a fully configured and functioning environment as described in the following sections. Each component must be verified to work individually and as a complete solution.

- You must run the HP Cloud Content Capsule Installer on the server, where you installed HP CSA.
- You must have the Java SE Runtime Environment (JRE) version 7u11 or later installed on the server.
- If you use the Graphical UI, you must ensure that all the required graphics packages are configured on the server.
- The HP Cloud Content Capsule Installer is designed to work in graphical and non-graphical environment. A non-graphical (silent/headless-mode) installation process also exists. For information about silent mode, see the "Importing the capsule" topic in the HPE DMA *Database Capsule User Guide*.
