QCCR1E129693	You must import the application core unload file before starting to configure a Service Manager-SAP integration.	The Service Manager-SAP integration applications code is now included in Service Manager out-of-box.

Fixed defects

This software release fixes the following defects.

Global ID	Problem	Solution
QCCR1E129554	The SMSSMEX 1.10 P2 integration failed to start with license error - IP Address validation Failed.	The SMSSMEX 1.10 P2 integration works on all IP adresses.

Known Problems, Limitations, and Workarounds

This software release includes the following known issues and limitations.

Global ID	Problem	Workaround
QCCR1E135585	When the attachment white list is enabled, if web service requests did not send the extension name of the attachment, the attachment is rejected and the request fails.	To workaround this issue, add a new startup parameter denyattachwithoutext to the sm.ini file. For more information, see Service Manager Help Center > Administer > System configuration parameters > Security parameters > denyattachwithoutext.
QCCR1E126649	Failed to invoke the GUI wizard to install SMSSMEX on SUSE12.	There is currently no workaround available.
QCCR1E128958	When running non-PD in Service Manager 9.41 Hybrid mode, Service Manager tickets are closed directly if the solution is rejected by SAP Solution Manager.	To workaround this issue, change the condition of auto transition from In Process Closure to Status in CurrentRecord = "Closed" in the Migrated Incident workflow.
QCCR1E128778	Error occurs when upgrading from SM 9.31 with PDCP3 to 9.41 Hybrid.	To workaround this issue, apply a hotfix for QCCR1E128778 during the SM 9.31 with PD3 to SM 9.41 Hybrid upgrade process. The hotfix is available from HPE Software Support.
