Fixed Defects in this Release

CR	Problem	Solution
QCCR1E136394	When you manually start scenario with JMS for IBM WebSphere MQ connector, you see a "opening session..." label in the Connect-It Log. In addition, the scenario stops responding and does not read data from MQ queue (not empty).	This issue is fixed by a code change.
QCCR1E136366	An error message pops up when you use ODBC Excel Driver.	The "OdbcCursorConcurrency" option should not be used for all ODBC drivers. Its default value is now set to 0.
QCCR1E135845	The password is asked every time you run the scenario with Lotus Notes on Windows 2012.	The following text is added in the connector guide. Note: If the user.id is put in a customized path, you need to edit the "KeyFileName" item of notes.ini. For example, if the user.id is put in C:\lotus_node_user_id\user.id, the item should be "KeyFileName=C:\lotus_node_user_id\user.id."
QCCR1E136335	Connect-It cannot empty a field of "Date" type in UCMDB.	A JVM property named cit.ucmdb.write.null is added. If this property is set to true, UCMDB connector can write null values to UCMDB. If it is set to false, null values are ignored and are not written in UCMDB.
