## Definitions

Capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this ALA document are defined in the governing agreement.

TERM	DEFINITION	
Concurrent Access	means simultaneous use of one Device at any point in time.	
Concurrent Flow <i>or</i> CC Flow	means the number of individual, simultaneous flows that can be run at any point in time. Flow represents the bi-directional communication between specified source and target in which a single network condition is applied (source and target can be the local machine, a remote host or range of hosts).	
Concurrent User <i>or</i> CC User	means the software is licensed by the amount of users that simultaneously use the software at any one point in time. The software can be installed on any number of computers, provided that the actual usage of the software does not exceed the number of licenses purchased.	
Device <i>or</i> Dev	means an addressable entity, physical or virtual, including but not limited to router, switch, bridge, hub, server, PC, laptops, handheld device or printer that resides within the range defined for interrogation and asset tracking.	
E-LTU and E-Media	means products which are electronically delivered only, and as such any reference to FOB Destination or delivery methods that are stated on your purchase order other than electronic shall be null and void with respect to these E-LTU or E-Media products.	

TERM	DEFINITION	
LTU	means License To Use.	
Location	means an end-point where a BPM Transaction can be run from. The same BPM Transaction is often run from multiple locations such as differe city or country office locations.	
Mobile Device <i>or</i> Mbl Dev	means a Device running an operating system designed for mobile devices such as but not limited to mobile phones, tablet computers and smar phones that typically connect to a network by means of Wi-Fi or cellular data.	
Node Locked Instance	means an Instance which can only be used with a specific node.	
Suite	means two or more software products combined into a single license offering or a single software product which includes two or more licenses. The specific software products included in a Suite are specified in the software specific license terms below. Software products included in a Suit are governed by the individual authorizations and use restrictions associated with each software product, except where specified in the specific Suite software specific license terms below.	
Term License to Use or Term LTU	means a software license to use (LTU) which indicates in its license description that the license is valid for a specific period of time such as One Month (IM), One Year (1Y) etc. Term LTU's are not perpetual licenses.	
Term Support	means a fixed period support offering that is only valid during the time period of the associated Term LTU.	
Transaction <i>or</i> Txn	means a series of distinct actions relevant for monitoring an IT service or process. It is represented and stored in software as a single, unique measuring capability for a stated Key Performance Indicator (KPI).	
Unlimited <i>or</i> Unl	means without restrictions in terms of number of systems, devices or media, depending on the context.
