The distribution is a complete installer and the file is called *hpe-systinet-10.03.jar*. For installation instructions, refer to the *HPE Systinet Installation and Configuration Guide*.

### **Known Issues and Limitations**

The version of HPE Systinet has the following known issues or limitations:

- 1. Integration of UDDI, BSM, ALM and Data Power RGIF servers are not supported.
- 2. The hot fixes of the following versions of HPE Systinet are not part of this release:
  - a. Systinet 4.03.
  - b. Systinet 4.10.
  - c. Systinet 10.00.
  - d. Systinet 10.01.
  - e. Systinet 10.02.
- 3. Migrating your data from 10.0x to 10.03 has the following know issues:
  - a. The import fails, if you try to import relations from the script ipep-api.

**Root Cause**: The script ipep-api is a system artifact and is not imported in normal import mode.

**Resolution**: Make the script ipep-api as a non-system artifact, so that it is imported and overwrite the one in the repository.

To overwrite the file, open the file SYSTINET\_HOME/conf/migrationblacklist.txt and remove the following:

```
script/ipep-api
```

b. The import fails, if you try importing lifecycle processes.

**Root Cause**:Two or more lifecycle processes are applied to same artifact type with **Automatically Assigned** set to **True**.

**Resolution**: Keep only on default lifecycle process for one artifact type. Set the **Automatically Assigned** value to **False** and change the **defaultProcess** tag in the image to **False**.

c. UI customization is not imported because of changes in UI configuration schema in HPE Systinet 10.03.

**Root Cause**: In HPE Systinet 10.03, the tag for UI configuration is different than that of the tag in Systinet 10.02. Hence it will no longer be valid.

#### **Resolution**: To update the tag, follow these steps:

- i. Open the file EXPORTED\_IMAGE/configuration/configuration-properties.xml
- ii. Search for .uiconfig and change all the role to uiRole.

- 4. The following known limitations will be fixed in the next release (10.04):
  - For importing a WSDL file, the synchronize option is not available in the View page (Internal Defect ID 18741).
  - b. Synchronize tab is not available in the **Collection** page of Service Artifact (Internal Defect ID 19766).
  - c. For Analyst login, the events are not getting updated (Internal Defect ID 19740).
  - d. When importing .bpel file, the Business Process artifact is not getting created (Internal Defect ID 20522).
