New Features in this Release

The following new features are available with this release:

- **System Management Content Pack changes:** You must install OBR 10.21 before you install or upgrade the latest version of System Management Content Pack.

OBR System Management content pack has been enhanced to simplify the collection of metrics from Operations Agent (OA).

Following are the metrics:

- GBL_CPU_INTERRUPT_UTIL (available from OA 12.0x)
 - GBL_SWAP_SPACE_AVAIL
 - GBL_SWAP_SPACE_USED
 - GBL_CPU_WAIT_TIME (available from OA 12.0x)
 - GBL_MEM_PAGEIN_BYTE_RATE
 - GBL_GMTOFFSET
 - GBL_CPU_IDLE_TIME
 - GBL_NET_ERROR_1_MIN_RATE
- **OBR Content Pack for Cloud Optimizer:** This new Content Pack integrates with Cloud Optimizer to obtain VMware virtualization performance metrics to generate reports on the performance of the virtual environment.

Download and Install Content Packs

You must download the content packs from HPE Marketplace and install them in your OBR system using the Administration Console.

You can download the latest Content Development Environment from [Marketplace](#) and install in your OBR system. For more information to download and install the Content Development Environment, see the *Operations Bridge Reporter Content Development Guide*.

To download and install content pack based on your requirement, follow these steps:

Download Content Pack

1. Go to [Marketplace](#).
2. Click **Sign in** at the top right corner of the page to log on. To register for a new ID, click **Sign up**.
3. Go to [Operations Bridge](#). From **All products** drop-down list select **Operations Bridge Reporter**.
4. Click the required content pack.
5. Perform any one of the following:
 - Scroll down and click **DOWNLOAD AS ZIP** for the required content pack version. The .zip file includes the zip of Windows and Linux content. OR
 - Click to download the **Linux** or **Windows** ZIP file based on your requirement.
6. Save the files to the OBR system. Follow these steps to extract the files:
 - a. To install the Content Pack in Windows:
 - i. Extract the ZIP file to a temporary folder.
 - ii. From the extracted files, double-click the MSI file and follow the instructions on the installer wizard.
 - b. To install the Content Pack in Linux:
 - i. Extract the contents of the ZIP file using the following command:

```
unzip <RPM file>
```
 - ii. From the extracted contents, enter the name of the RPM file in the following command:

```
rpm -U <RPM file>
```

Install Content Pack

Note:

- You must take a backup of all content customizations before upgrading the Content Pack.
- Before starting the System Management content pack upgrade, stop the HPE_PMDB_Platform_Collection service and allow other services to run for few hours, so that all the collected data is processed. Restart the HPE_PMDB_Platform_Collection service after the content pack upgrade.

1. Launch the OBR Administration Console.
2. Click **Content Pack Deployment**.
3. Select the content pack and click **Install / Upgrade**.

The installation completes in a few minutes.
