As of this date, the product will be removed from HPE's Corporate Price List and will no longer be orderable.

Answer	You have the option to continue using HPE Operations Bridge Reporter 10.0x & 10.1x.
	HPE will stop providing committed support for HPE Operations Bridge Reporter 10.0x on Dec 31, 2019. Extended Support will continue to be available through Dec 31, 2021. Self-Help Support with Rights to New Versions support will continue to be available through Dec 31, 2025.
	HPE will stop providing committed support for HPE Operations Bridge Reporter 10.1x on Feb 28, 2021. Extende Support will continue to be available through Feb 28, 2023. Self-Help Support with Rights to New Versions suppor will continue to be available through Feb 28, 2025.
	You are encouraged to begin reviewing your business requirements for HPE Operations Bridge Reporter 10.0x & 10.1x. You are also encouraged to contact your local HPE sales representative or HPE business partner for help i determining migration options that meet your business needs.
Question	Can I get a support contract for technical support only, without having to pay for updates?
