Fixes in the OMi MP for Oracle WebLogic 1.01 Release

Title: Weblogics Management Pack configuration Issue (QCIM8D39721).

Description: The Login or password is not provided for JMX connection in Weblogic_Config.txt. IO Exception and receiving only one event where we had received 2 events.

Title: Weblogics Management Pack configuration Issue-Unique Config ID issue in Config txt (**QCIM8D39871**).

Description: Config ID in Config,txt written by the weblogic Discovery isn't unique in the customer setup. The WEBLOGIC_INSTANCE against both the servers is referring to a common string.

Title: Weblogics Management Pack configuration Issue-Admin server connection returning more than 1 servers' data (**QCIM8D39872**).

Description: Admin server connection returning more than 1 servers' data. The admin server connection returns data of managed servers as well.

Title: Stop-Start monitoring failed intermittently (QCIM8D40047).

Description: Stop-Start monitoring failing intermittently. Weblogic_Perl Weblogic_Config.pl will start monitoring and Weblogic_Perl Weblogic_Config.pl stopMonitoring will stop monitoring .

Title: Weblogic Discovery issue (QCIM8D51554).

Description: Weblogic Discovery issue that the aspect does not contain the weblogic_configuration template.

Title: JDBC Pool Utilization in Weblogic Monitoring shows Zero Value { Delta Value } (QCIM8D52157).

Description: JDBC Pool Utilization in weblogic monitoring Weblogic MP shows zero value. It should not report zero value.

Title: ER:Garbage Collection Count & Time not collecting on the servers { through JMX } (QCIM8D52540).

Description: Currently on some Weblogic Servers, cant see below mbeans.

Title: Customer is missing WEBLOGIC_DATA datasource entries for certain classes although the corresponding metrics have been assigned (**QCIM8D52902**).

Description: Customer is missing WEBLOGIC_DATA datasource entries for certain classes although the corresponding metrics have been assigned.

Title: False WebLogic Server status Events reported to OMi (QCIM8D53063).

Description: False WebLogic Server status Events reported to OMi. Encountered an critical event for Weblogic Server status down for Port 7101.

Title: Not part of class WEBLOGIC_JDBC_CPTY under datasource WEBLOGIC_DATA (**QCIM8D53150**).

Description: Encountered the below error in /var/opt/OV/log/Weblogic/collectionManager/CollectionManager.log. There is no parts of class WEBLOGIC_JDBC_CPTY under datasource WEBLOGIC_DATA.

Title: Discovery issue with Weblogic MP active-active cluster, mismatch of managed server details discovered (**QCIM8D53168**).

Description: Active-active Weblogic cluster setup we can see mismatch of managed server details discovered on both Weblogic nodes.

Known Problems and Workarounds

Title: Monitoring Automation fails to undeploy Aspects from deleted Configuration Items (CIs) if properties are resolved from these CIs (**QCCR8D30525**).

Description: Undeployment of Weblogic Discovery Aspect removes the CIs but does not remove the assignments associated with the Weblogic Discovery Aspect. For more information, see **QCCR8D30525** for OMi.

Workaround: Before undeploying the Weblogic Discovery Aspect, you must make sure to delete the CI assignments associated with the Weblogic Discovery Aspect.

Title: The License capacity is not updated under License Management for non-monitored nodes on BSM (**QCCR8D21568**).

Description: The License capacity is not updated under License Management on the BSM server when the license counts are reduced. For more information, see **QCCR8D21568** for OMi.

Workaround: None.

Title: libOvParam runtime link error for libovperl.so on Solaris (QCCR1A175210).

Description: OMi Management Pack for Oracle WebLogic monitoring may not work for Solaris nodes. For more information, see **QCCR1A175210** for Operations Agent.

Workaround: None.
