Title: An email address with more than four characters after the dot is not accepted by VM Explorer.

**Description:**In the Settings > E-Mail Default Settings, when a sender/ receiver email address is updated with more than four characters after the dot, an error message appears stating **Email address not valid. Ex: test@test.tests**. The algorithm is updated to recognize valid email addresses. **Ex: test@test.test** 

QCCR number: QCIM2A77400

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Title: Restore is not possible after an upgrade to VM Explorer 6.7.001

**Description:** After an update to VM Explorer 6.7.001, the target directory can not be selected while trying to perform a restore operation.
