



How to configure Microsoft's Edge browser for ALM:

1. Check your Microsoft Edge version
 - a. Open the Edge browser
 - b. Click the ellipses (...) in the top right corner of the browser
 - c. Click "Help and feedback" and then click "About Microsoft Edge"
 - d. On the next page you will see the version number:
 - i. The below image shows **88.0.705.81 (Official build) (64-bit)**.
 1. The first 2 numbers are the 'version' -- **88**
 2. The number is the "Build" -- **88.0.705.81**
 3. The "64-bit" is your "Platform"
 4. You will need this info for the next step



To enable IE Mode with Policy Template: - you will need to download the 'msedge.adm':

2. Download the Microsoft Edge Policy Template
 - a. Go to <https://www.microsoft.com/en-us/edge/business/download>
 - b. Specify your version, build, and platform. The information is show above



- c. Click the "GET POLICY FILES" link to start the download.
3. Save the downloaded file and unzip the file (MicrosoftEdgePolicyTemplates.zip)

Add the "msedge.adm" file into Administrative Templates:

4. Find the "msedge.adm" file in the **{MicrosoftEdgePolicyTemplates}\windows\adm\en-US** – from the unzipped file location.

In the Local Group Policy Editor

5. Launch the Local Group Policy Editor (you can launch it by Run > gpedit.msc)
6. In the left pane, right click on the “User Configuration>Administrative Templates folder”
7. Select “Add /Remove Templates”
8. Click the “Add” button on the next popup
9. Locate the “msedge.adm” file in the **{MicrosoftEdgePolicyTemplates}\windows\adm\en-US**
– from the unzipped file location
10. Click the file msedge.adm
11. Then click on ‘Open’
12. Then click ‘Close’
13. In the Local Group Policy Editor main window, in the left pane navigate to User Configuration>Administrative Templates > Classic Administrative Templates (ADM)
14. Click the folder “Microsoft Edge” to open this.
15. Click on “Setting” to sort this list alphabetically
16. Find the “Configure Internet Explorer Integration item”
17. Right click on “Configure Internet Explorer Integration item” and select edit
18. Click on the button next to “Enabled”
19. In the Options section, from the drop down select “Internet Explorer mode”
20. Click ok to save these settings.
21. Keep the “Local Group Policy Editor” open – you will come back to this
22. Create a file named: sites.xml file
 - a. Open notepad and paste the below information in. Save this file to a permanent location with the name: **sites.xml** – remember where you save this file for the next step.



Enable and fill the ‘Configure the Enterprise Mode Site List’ field with the path where you place the xml file.


23. Go back to the Local Group Policy Editor, Navigate back to “User Configuration>Administrative Templates > Classic Administrative Templates (ADM) >Microsoft Edge”
24. Find in the list “Configure the Enterprise Mode Site List”
25. Right click on “Configure the Enterprise Mode Site List” and select edit
26. Click on the button next to “Enabled”
27. In the Options section, paste the full location of the sites.xml file with the name.
 - a. Example: **C:\Temp\MicrosoftEdgePolicyTemplates\Sites\sites.xml**
28. Click ok to save these settings.
29. Close the Local Group Policy Editor

Edit the below 3 local registry settings – using regedit:

- HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Policies\Microsoft\Edge
 >InternetExplorerIntegrationLevel (REG_DWORD) with value 1 (or decimal: 0x00000001)



- HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Policies\Microsoft\Internet Explorer\Main\EnterpriseMode >SiteList (REG_SZ) with path to your XML-sitelist



- HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Policies\Microsoft\MicrosoftEdge>Main\EnterpriseMode >SiteList (REG_SZ) with path to your XML-sitelist



Restart Edge and visit the ALM URL. ALM should open in the EDGE in IE mode automatically.
