## Known Issues

### Incorrect file permissions on the HP-UX data-palette-collect script

---

**PROBLEM:** The permissions on the `/sbin/init.d/data-palette-collect` file are incorrect. This causes a failure when you attempt to manage the HP-UX collector via system startup scripts.

---

**SYMPTOM:** When you execute the following command:  
`/sbin/init.d/data-palette-collect status`  
The following error message is displayed:  
`ksh: /sbin/init.d/data-palette-collect: cannot execute`

---

**WORKAROUND:** Change the permissions on `/sbin/init.d/data-palette-collect` to `-rwxr-xr-x`
