This version of Connect-It provides the following updates and enhancements:

Connector and Scenario Updates

New connector

• Universal CMDB Connector (9.01)

This new connector was added to support UCMDB 9.01 via the Java API of UCMDB.

Removed connectors

- CA Unicenter AMO 3 and AMO 4
- HP Network Inventory
- HP Desktop Inventory 7.x and 8.x (PDI)

New support for existing connectors

• Action Request System (ARS) Connector

This connector now supports ARS versions 6.3, 7, and 7.5. There are also new updates to the required DLL files.

• Project and Portfolio Management (PPM) Center Connector

This connector now supports PPM Center versions 8.02 and 8.1.

• Email Connectors

These connectors now support IPv6 and Microsoft Exchange server 2007 and 2010.

AssetCenter/Asset Manager Connector

This connector now supports Asset Manager 5.22.

• Discovery and Dependency Mapping (DDM) Inventory Connector

This connector now supports DDM Inventory version 7.7.

Connectors that use the Database Connector

These connectors now support SQL Server 2008.

Removed support for existing connectors

• Tally Systems TS.Census 2.x and TS.Census 3.0

This connector no longer supports versions 2 and 3.0. Note that TS.Census 3.1 and 3.2 are still supported.

HP Enterprise Discovery

Connectors for these versions have been removed: 2.0, 2.1, and 2.2.

• HP Configuration Management

This connector no longer supports version 4.1.

AssetCenter/Asset Manager Connector

This connector no longer supports versions 3.6, 4.2.x, and 4.3.x.

This connector no longer supports version 6.x.

Email Connectors

• Access Request System (ARS) Connector

QCCR1E51460	Connect-It 4.0: An error occurs while opening the Asset Manager connector.

QCCR1E51470	Connect-It 3.91: While attempting to create a new scenario and viewing the data associated with the IMAP connector's InMailMessage document type, the

QCCR1E51991	The Email Fetching connector always crashes after 30 sessions when running on a schedule.
QCCR1E52114	For Lotus Notes messages, the names of attachments do not appear correctly when accentuated characters are in the file name and the IMAP protocol is used.
QCCR1E52192	The documentation and the connector configuration details suggests that the VIM protocol is still supported, although it is not.
QCCR1E52214	The following error occurs while running scenario ucmdbac.scn: Name 'interfaces' is not defined in element " and Name 'disks' is not defined in element'.
