HP SiteScope 11.10 - Documentation Updates Configuring BSM 9.01 to work with SiteScope 11.10 VMware Host Monitors

Perform the following procedures to enable support for the new VMware Host monitors when SiteScope 11.10 is reporting data to BSM 9.01.

Documentation Updates

Update Topology Scripts

- In BSM 9.01, select Admin > RTSM Administration > Package Manager, find the package named sitescope and export it to a local directory.
- 2. After export is complete, make a backup of the file (sitescope.zip).
- 3. Extract the contents of **sitescope.zip** to a separate directory.
- 4. Delete the **discoveryScripts** folder from the directory to which you extracted SiteScope.
- Copy the discoveryScripts folder from Enabling_VMware_Host_Monitors_on_BSM901.zip (available from the HP Software Self-solve knowledge base <u>http://support.openview.hp.com/selfsolve/document/KM1156454</u>), to the directory to which you extracted SiteScope.
- 6. Archive the previously extracted structure. Make sure that the directory structure is the same as in the original file.
- 7. In BSM 9.01, go to the RTSM Package Manager and deploy the updated archive back to the server.

Update Indicator Assignments

- In BSM 9.01, select Admin > System Availability Management > Metrics and Indicators, click the Select Monitor button, and then click the New Monitor button.
- 2. Create the 5 new VMware Host monitors, and enter the following information:

| VMware Host CPU Monitor | VMwareHostCPUMonitor | Virtualization |
| VMware Host Memory Monitor | VMwareHostMemoryMonitor | Virtualization |

| VMware Host State Monitor | VMwareHostStateMonitor | Virtualization |
| VMware Host Storage Monitor | VMwareHostStorageMonitor | Virtualization |

- Import the vmware host assignments.xml file from Enabling_VMware_Host_Monitors_on_BSM901.zip to Monitor Indicator Assignments.
- 4. Restart the SiteScope integrated with BSM 9.01.
