AssetCenter Web 4.4 Tailoring Kit Release Notes

Welcome to Peregrine Systems, Inc. AssetCenter Web 4.4 product. This maintenance release only contains changes that relate to the updated source code. There are no new enhancements or features.

AssetCenter 4.4 uses a dedicated release of OAA version 4.2 for AssetCenter Web. The OAA server components of AssetCenter Web 4.4 must be installed separately from other OAA production servers.

Key features of AssetCenter Web

The AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit includes the following.

Component	Description
Peregrine Studio	A graphical development tool that you can use to customize AssetCenter Web.
AssetCenter Web source files	An editable Peregrine Studio project file for AssetCenter Web.

Compatibility Matrix

The Compatibility Matrix lists supported versions of operating systems, browsers, Peregrine products, and other compatibility and support information. To access the Compatibility Matrix:

Software Change Requests

AssetCenter Web 4.4 Tailoring Kit includes fixes for Software Change Requests (SCRs). The following table describes enhancements to the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit as well as issues fixed in this release.

SCR	Description
SCR 25696	In the previous releases of Peregrine Portal, the label entered in Peregrine Studio for a Translated Value Field (translated) was not displayed. The label now displays the same as other fields.
SCR 30180	Composite fields now render together on the same line when possible.
SCR 30221	Defining column headings that contain variable tokens (that is, \$\$ (variable)) now works correctly.
SCR 30829	Timespan fields now work correctly when added to a form with Studio.
SCR 32050	Studio-defined sidebar HTML content now works correctly.
SCR 32470	You can now use underscore bars in the form part of the name of a Studio-defined form, but they are still not permitted as a module or activity name.
SCR 34095	Use UTF-8 encoding, not US_ASCII, so that the generated XML forms have the proper encoding to support the use of non-English default and display values.

Known issues

The following table describes known issues and temporary solutions for the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit. To search the KnowledgeBase for known issues, type the Known Issue Document ID (enclosed in quotation marks) as the search criteria.

Issue	Temporary Solution
When trying to edit a label for a <code>fieldtableheading</code> or <code>fieldtablerow</code> component, there is no label field displayed in the tab view.	Select the <code>fieldtable</code> component in the Project Explorer. This will display the <code>fieldtable</code> on the right side of the Studio window. Select the Columns tab. The label can be edited in the label area.
AssetCenter Web generates ECMAScript errors when trying to find scripts and schemas with mixed case names.	All ECMAScript and schema names should be in lower case.
Tailoring changes made to the <code>explorerUtil</code> script do not appear at run time.	This script should not be tailored directly. Instead, you should copy <code>explorerUtil</code> into a custom script and make any desired changes there.
When you first open your project in Peregrine Studio, a conflict icon (red exclamation point) is displayed next to the Project node.	No conflict resolution is required. You can ignore this conflict warning.
Enabling the Entity Documentation files and Connect.It DSD files build options from Peregrine Studio produces build errors.	Neither of these build options are required for AssetCenter Web builds. Clear these build options and rebuild your AssetCenter Web project.
The <code>readOnlytextarea</code> attribute in Studio has no effect on how the text is rendered, thus newlines characters are lost. [SCR 30186]	None.
