Software Requirements

The following describe the software requirements for the Executive Scorecard components:

Operating System Requirements

All servers in the Executive Scorecard component deployment (SAP BusinessObjects Enterprise for IT Executive Scorecard server, Data Warehouse server, and Executive Scorecard server), must have Windows ® operating system (Microsoft Windows Server 2008 R2 64 bit Enterprise) installed as their operating system. Your RDBMS is not required to run on Microsoft Windows Server 2008

R2 64 bit Enterprise.

All component systems must be joined to the same Windows server domain.

RDBMS Requirements

1. IT IT Executive Scorecard currently supports Microsoft SQL Server 2008 Enterprise Edition with SP 2 as the Relational Database Management System (RDBMS).

Note: This version of IT Executive Scorecard only supports using the default instance of the SQL Server.

Obtain Microsoft SQL Server 2008 Enterprise Edition with SP 2 software and license keys directly from Microsoft Corporation. The Microsoft SQL Server 2008 Enterprise Edition with SP 2 should be set up before you begin your IT Executive Scorecard deployment.

- 2. Ensure that you configure in your Microsoft SQL Server 2008 Enterprise Edition with SP 2 with the following:
 - Mixed Mode Authentication for the RDBMS Database Engine.
 - TCP/IP enabled as a communications protocol for MS SQL Server.

License Requirements

During the Executive Scorecard Configuration, you are required to enter the application license details. You can purchase a permanent license for Executive Scorecard, or alternately use an evaluation license that is valid for 60 days and extend it with a temporary license if necessary.

If you have an existing SAP BusinessObjects Enterprise for IT Executive Scorecard installation, you can use that instance. If you purchase SAP BusinessObjects Enterprise for IT Executive Scorecard with the HP Executive Scorecard, the purchase includes the required licenses.

Other applications that generate or use data, require separate licenses. Data Warehouse Server Software Requirements

Install the following on the Data Warehouse server, before you start the Data Warehouse component installation:

- 1. Install the SQLCMD utility as follows:
 - a. On the Microsoft SQL Server 2008 Enterprise Edition with SP 2 CD, run Setup.

Note: If you did not previously install .NET Framework 3.5.1 on your server, you may be prompted to install Microsoft .NET Framework. When installing .NET Framework 3.5.1, ensure that WCF Activation is unchecked.

b. Select New SQL Server Standalone Installation.

c. On the feature Select screen, select **Management Tools - Basic**, unselect **Management Tools - Complete**, and finish the Wizard.

Note: If you want to use the default HTTP port in the Executive Scorecard installation, ensure that the port the one, that was configured during post-installation configuration, is available after the installation of the SQLCMD tool.

2. Microsoft Excel 2007 - This must be installed if you intend using the Excel spreadsheets provided by Data Warehouse. Because the use of Excel spreadsheets is optional, the pre-install checks inform you if it is not installed but allows you to carry on with the installation.

Executive Scorecard Client Requirements

Currently Microsoft Internet Explorer 8 is supported.

For full dashboard functionality, ensure that you have the following installed:

- 1. Adobe® Flash® player versions 10.3.x
- 2. JRE version 1.6.x

Additional Requirements

- It is recommended that you set your browser Zoom Level to 100%. A Zoom level higher than 100% might result in some of the components not displaying properly in the Dashboard.
- The recommended screen resolution when viewing the Executive Scorecard application is 1280x1024.
- It is recommended that you reset the browser settings to the default settings.
- Adobe® *Reader*® version 9 and above to enable you to read the documentation in PDF format.

Distributed Server Environment

Although you can install all components on a single server, the typical configuration is a distributed environment where each networked server hosts a specific component.

Third-party components, such as databases and operating systems, are supported at the minor level, unless a different minimum level is specified. Future maintenance and patch releases (including fix packs or service packs) on the same minor release are expected to be supported, unless a conflict specific to that release arises.

Localization
