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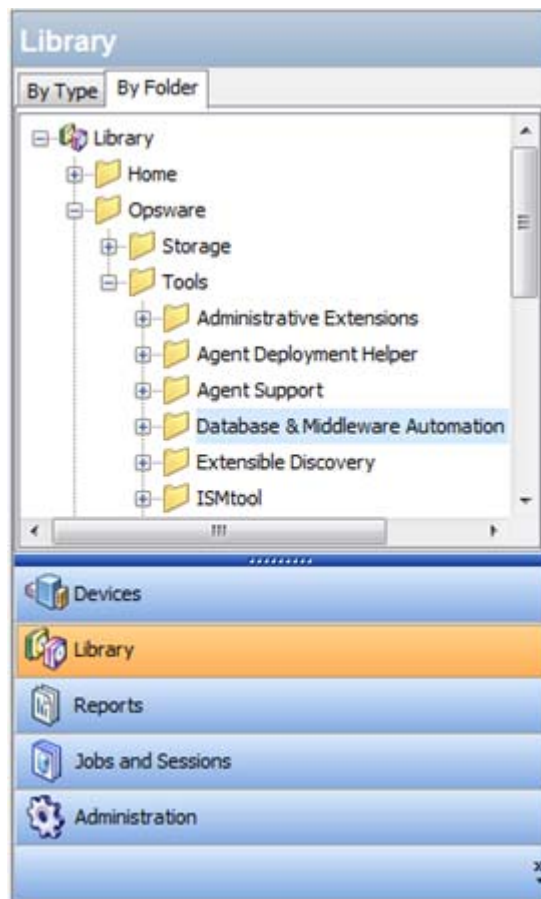
Post Installation Steps for Database and Middleware Automation

After you upgrade to a new version of Server Automation(SA), you must perform the following procedure to enable Database and Middleware Automation (HP DMA) to run workflows in your upgraded SA environment.

- ▶ You must have permission to remediate software policy on the pertinent devices (see “Software Management Permissions” in the *HP Server Automation Administration Guide*).

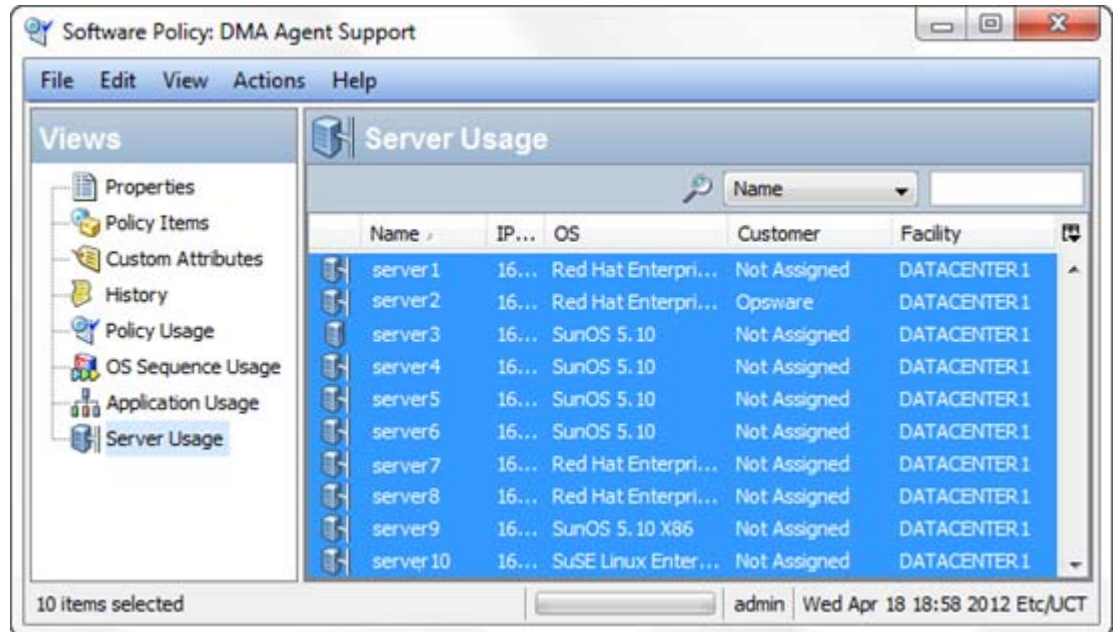
To enable HP DMA workflows to run after an SA upgrade:

- 1 In the SA client, go to the Library, and select the **By Folder** tab..
- 2 Expand the following folder: Opsware/Tools
- 3 Select Database & Middleware Automation.

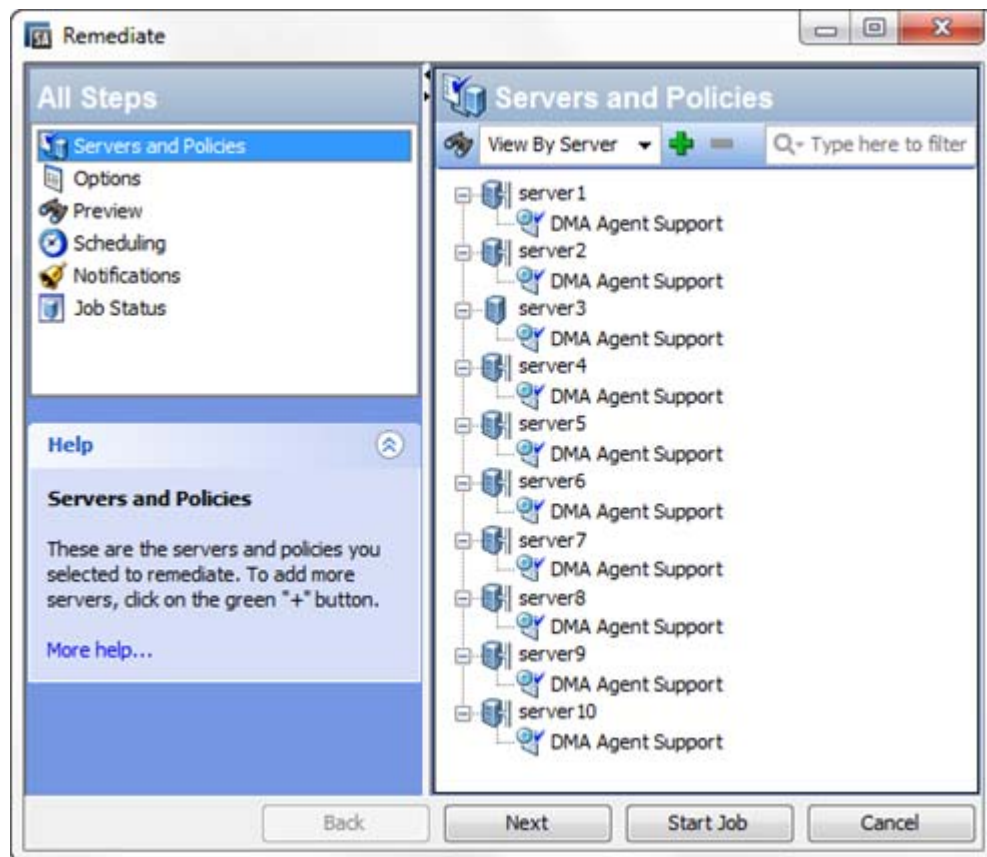


- 4 Open the DMA Agent Support software policy.
- 5 In the Views pane, select **Server Usage**.

- 6 Click somewhere in the Server Usage pane, and press CTRL + A to select all the servers.



- 7 Right click, and select **Remediate**.



- 8 In the Remediate window, click **Start Job**.

After you perform this procedure, all SA managed servers that currently have the DMA Agent Support policy will be remediated with the updated version of that policy.
