Installing License Keys for HP Operations Manager

To use HP Operations Manager (HPOM), you must have a valid license. The following is the procedure to install an Autopass license, a .dat file, or several .dat files that HP sent to you.

1. Call the ovolicense tool to open the AutoPass GUI:

ovolicense –g –a HPOM

- 2. In the GUI, select Install License Key -> Install/Restore License Key from file.
- 3. Click the **Browse** button to select the password file.
- 4. Click **View file contents**.
- 5. Select the license passwords in the list and click **Install**.
