HP CSA 3.00 Content

HP CSA is shipped with pre-developed service designs and resource offerings that can be customized for your use. You can import and export this “content” developed for specific HP CSA applications, and adapt it to your business needs.

The out-of-the-box content shipped with this version of HP CSA is stored in a library folder on the HP CSA media. In addition, you can access downloadable content at the HP Live Network website: <https://www.www2.hp.com/> Access to this site is restricted. HP customers must have an active HP support agreement ID (SAID) for HP Cloud Service Automation and an HP Passport sign-in to access the data on this site. For more sample services designs and sample resource offerings, see your HP Professional Services Representative.

RAM	4 -6 GB (2 GB JVM heap)
Hard Drive	~ 10 GB (increases depending on the amount of log activity)

Minimum system requirements for installing an HP CSA database server are shown below:

CPU	4 CPU , 3.0 Ghz
RAM	8 GB
Hard Drive	~ 20 GB
