## Compatibility matrix

## Features

The following sections describe the new features of the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit.

### Custom portal components

You can create and add your own custom portal components with the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit.

### Integration with Rhino JavaScript Debugger

You can now configure the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit to integrate with the Rhino JavaScript debugger provided by Mozilla. The Rhino JavaScript Debugger provides a graphical user interface for debugging interpreted JavaScript and ECMAScript. When you enable the Rhino JavaScript Debugger, you can log on to the AssetCenter Web server and see debugging information about your installation as you browse through the AssetCenter Web interface.

### Schema extensions

You can make additions or changes to existing schemas using schema extensions. Schema extensions allow you to save customized logical and physical mappings in separate files that preserve the original schema files shipped by Peregrine Systems. This separate file organization ensures that any upgrades will not overwrite your tailoring changes.

The following sections describe the known issues and temporary solutions for the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit.

### AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit

The following table lists the known issues and temporary solutions for the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit.

Issue	Temporary Solution
<p>Uninstalling the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit requires removing any instance of AssetCenter Web that is also on the system.</p> <p>In addition, the uninstallation process removes any installed services for the Apache web server and the Tomcat application server on the system.</p> <p>[ST28309]</p>	<p>To uninstall the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit and preserve your development environment settings:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Save a copy of the following application data to recreate your development environment: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ WEB-INF\local.xml</li> <li>■ all files under WEB-INF\etc\grtrees\user\</li> </ul> </li> <li>2 Uninstall the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit.</li> <li>3 Uninstall the Peregrine Portal.</li> <li>4 Re-install the Java 2 SDK</li> <li>5 Re-install AssetCenter Web and any other Get-It applications you had installed.</li> <li>6 Re-install the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit.</li> <li>7 Restore your AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit data.</li> </ol> <p>To fully uninstall the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Uninstall the AssetCenter Web Tailoring Kit.</li> <li>2 Uninstall the Peregrine Portal.</li> </ol>

## Peregrine Studio

The following table lists the known issues and temporary solutions for Peregrine Studio.

Issue	Temporary Solution
<p>On the Tools menu, select Options &gt; Advanced. In the Advanced dialog box, all options can be selected.</p>	<p><b>Do not activate any Advanced options except “Use HTTP listener.”</b> You can select the HTTP Listener option if you have set “Display Form Information” to <i>true</i> to access Peregrine Studio forms directly from Web interface.</p> <p>If you use the other advanced options to edit source packages or the tools library, you may not be able to install future versions of AssetCenter Web. Any modifications made using Advanced Options will invalidate your Support agreement with Peregrine.</p>
<p>When adding a template to a form, the template is not added properly if you use a drag-and-drop method or copy and paste the template.</p>	<p>To add a template to a form, right-click on the form. Select <b>New</b>, and then the template you want from the menu.</p>
<p>When trying to edit a label for a fieldtableheading or fieldtable row component, there is no label field displayed in the tab view.</p>	<p>Select the fieldtable component in the Project Explorer. This will display the fieldtable on the right side of the Studio window. Select the Columns tab. The label can be edited in the label area.</p>
<p>When you first open your project in Peregrine Studio, a conflict icon (red exclamation point) is displayed next to the Project node.</p>	<p>No conflict resolution is required. You can ignore this conflict warning.</p>

Issue	Temporary Solution
Your first attempt to build your project produces compile errors.	Before attempting to build the Web application project in Peregrine Studio for the first time, do the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="795 282 1099 305">1 Open the your project file.</li><li data-bbox="795 317 1210 373">2 From the <b>Build</b> menu, select <b>Project</b> settings.</li><li data-bbox="795 385 1210 440">3 On the <b>Build Options</b> tab, locate the <b>Builder activation</b> section.</li><li data-bbox="795 453 1210 508">4 Clear the <b>Entity Documentation files</b> and <b>Connect.It DSD files</b> options.</li><li data-bbox="795 520 926 543">5 Click <b>OK</b>.</li><li data-bbox="795 555 1047 578">6 Rebuild your project.</li></ol>
Tailoring changes do no appear in web interface because Tomcat does not update cache. [ST26975]	If you are using the Tomcat 4.1.x family of application servers, you should delete the cache in the <b>work</b> folder every time you deploy changes.
Using the <b>Clean the target folders</b> option from the Peregrine Studio Build menu deletes necessary files and folders from the AssetCenter Web installation. [ST28424]	This option is no longer supported. To recover your deleted files, you will need to redeploy AssetCenter Web from the installation CD.
