# 1 Upgrading the HPCA Configuration Analyzer

Use the information in this guide to upgrade the HP Client Automation (HPCA) Configuration Analyzer to version 7.50.

The following HPCA Configuration Analyzer versions can be upgraded to version 7.50 using this guide:

• 4.x, 5. x, or 7.20

Based on your current Configuration Analyzer version, see the following procedures to upgrade an existing Configuration Analyzer HPCA Configuration Analyzer Version 7.50:

## To Migrate from Version 4.x

- 1 Use the **Add or Remove Programs**, Control Panel applet to remove the Configuration Analyzer. Then, restart the computer.
- 2 Install the latest Configuration Analyzer using the HPCA 7.50 media. The installer is located in:

The CA Configuration Analyzer is installed to the \Configuration Analyzer folder under the selected installation directory. For example, if you accept the default location, it is installed to:

C:\Program Files\Hewlett-Packard\CM\Configuration Analyzer

## To Migrate from Version 5.x or 7.20

The Configuration Analyzer supports a direct upgrade from versions 5.x, 5.1x and 7.20. The existing Configuration Analyzer does *not* need to be removed before running the latest installation. The installation media is on the 7.50 in the following location:

\extended infrastructure\configuration analyzer\ConfigurationAnalyzer.msi

The CA Configuration Analyzer is installed to the \Configuration Analyzer folder under the selected installation directory. For example, if you accept the default location, it is

C:\Program Files\Hewlett-Packard\CM\Configuration Analyzer
