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1 Upgrading the HPCA Configuration Analyzer

Use the information in this guide to upgrade the HP Client Automation (HPCA) Configuration Analyzer to version 7.50.

The following HPCA Configuration Analyzer versions can be upgraded to version 7.50 using this guide:

- 4.x, 5. x, or 7.20

To Migrate from Version 4.x

- 1 Use the **Add or Remove Programs**, Control Panel applet to remove the Configuration Analyzer. Then, restart the computer.
- 2 Install the latest Configuration Analyzer using the HPCA 7.50 media. The installer is located in:

```
\extended_infrastructure\configuration_analyzer\ConfigurationAnalyzer.msi
```

The CA Configuration Analyzer is installed to the \Configuration Analyzer folder under the selected installation directory. For example, if you accept the default location, it is installed to:

```
C:\Program Files\Hewlett-Packard\CM\Configuration Analyzer
```

To Migrate from Version 5.x or 7.20

The Configuration Analyzer supports a direct upgrade from versions 5.x, 5.1x and 7.20. The existing Configuration Analyzer does *not* need to be removed before running the latest installation. The installation media is on the 7.50 in the following location:

```
\extended_infrastructure\configuration_analyzer\ConfigurationAnalyzer.msi
```

The CA Configuration Analyzer is installed to the \Configuration Analyzer folder under the selected installation directory. For example, if you accept the default location, it is

installed to:

C:\Program Files\Hewlett-Packard\CM\Configuration Analyzer



The Configuration Analyzer Database schema for Version 7.50 does not introduce any changes from Version 5.10 or 5.11 or 7.20. No database migration is required.
