This document contains information about HP OpenView GlancePlus Pak for the HP-UX Application Release in the Winter of 2003. This release of GlancePlus Pak is supported on the 11.0 and 11.11 releases of HP-UX.

NOTE The name MeasureWare Agent for UNIX has been replaced with HP OpenView Performance Agent (OV Performance Agent or OVPA) for UNIX throughout this document. However, the process names and software components operationally remain MeasureWare Agent (MWA).

Refer to each product's Release Notes for system patch requirements. The Release Notes documents are in `/opt/perf/ReleaseNotes/`. Their filenames are:

- GlancePlus Release Notes: `Glance`
- HP OpenView Performance Agent Release Notes: `Mwa`

Compatibility Information and Installation Requirements

- **Installation Requirements**

Before installing GlancePlus Pak, be sure that your system meets these minimum requirements.

System Requirements

- HP Integrity servers and workstations
- HP 9000 Series 700 or 800
- 32 MB RAM, 64MB virtual memory

Display Requirements

The following is required for running the GlancePlus Motif interface (gpm):

- HP X-terminal or X-workstation display, minimum of 1280 x 1024 resolution and 8-color planes

The following is required for running the GlancePlus character mode interface (glance):

- Terminals: HP 2392A, HP 700/44, HP 700/92, HP 700/94, VT100, or compatible terminal emulators, such as xterm, dtterm, or hpterm, under the X-Window system

Disk Requirements — Total of 100 MB

- 50 MB in the `/opt/perf/` directory for first-time installations of GlancePlus and OV Performance Agent
- 50 MB in the `/var/opt/perf/` directory for OV Performance Server Agent

Software Requirements

- HP-UX 11.0 and beyond with X-Windows libraries X11R6 and Motif libraries 2.1.
